REGULAR SESSION SUMMARY MINUTES

The Regular Session for June 4, 2024 was called to order by Mayor Frank Moran at 6:00pm in the Municipal Annex.

- Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance led by Cliff McGrady Hiram Police Department Chaplain.
- Mayor Moran read and presented Court Clerks Week Proclamation to Chief Court Clerk Sally Butterworth, and Court Clerks Angelica Frazier, and Jeanne Smith.
- Approved minutes from the May 7, 2024 Regular Session, the May 18, 2024 Budget Work Session, and the May 28, 2024 Work Session.
- Approved the Consent Agenda:
 - a. Authorizing the purchase of a road grinder and post driver system for Public Works, from Aramsco, DBA TransSafe, for an amount not to exceed \$36,389.26, to be funded by Street SPLOST.
 - b. Authorizing the purchase of a 2023 F-550 dump truck instead of the 2024 F-550 dump truck that was approved by council on March 5, 2024, Hardy Family Ford, through their Fleet Sales, for an amount not to exceed \$68,916.00, to be funded by Street SPLOST.
- Adopted Ordinance 2024-05 annexing the property at 3401 Nebo Road, owned by Jerry Moody, parcel ID#'s 217.1.1005.000, into the City Limits of Hiram.
- Consideration to adopt Ordinance 2024-06, rezoning of the property located at 29 Dallas Street from R2 to B1, was tabled to the June Work Session.
- Adopted Ordinance 2024-07, Indemnification Ordinance.
- Olde Town Hiram Business Association was determined recipient of the remaining disbursement of FY2024 Hotel Motel Excise Tax Funds.
- Olde Towne Hiram Business Association was determined recipient of the FY2025 Hotel Motel Excise Tax Disbursement.
- Adopted Ordinance 2024-08, approving the proposed FY2025 Budget, as presented at the May 28, 2024 Council Meeting.
- Rescheduled June Work Session to June 26 at 6pm.
- Mayor Moran mentioned upcoming events:
 - June 15: Juneteenth festival at Gray's Mill Park.
 - City Hall closed on June 19 in observance of Juneteenth
