## City Services

### **Water & Sewer Utility Billing**

An application and a \$200.00 deposit are required for all new accounts. Visit [www.huxleyiowa.org](http://www.huxleyiowa.org) and click "start service" to complete. The deposit is credited to a homeowners account after twelve consecutive on-time payments. The deposit will be applied to the account in the anniversary month of the move in date. The deposit will be noted on the bill when it is credited. Renters receive their deposit after they finalize their account.

### **Water Rates:**

\$20.30 monthly base fee  
\$8.24 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed  
Water Excise Tax: 6%

### **Sewer Rates:**

\$27.25 monthly base fee  
\$5.79 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed

### **Existing 2<sup>nd</sup> Meter Rates:**

\$10.60 monthly base fee  
\$12.72 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed

At the beginning of the month, city personnel will read the meter(s) at each residence to determine water usage. Bills are mailed around the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month and are to be paid in full by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month. On the 11<sup>th</sup> of the month, a \$20.00 late fee will be added to each account that is delinquent. Notice is given regarding the date of disconnection for non-payment. If water is disconnected for any reason, an \$80.00 reconnect fee will be charged to have water reestablished.

Please sign up for the Utility Billing Portal: <https://huxleyia.municipalonlinepayments.com/huxleyia> This portal offers the ability to sign up for text or email alerts, due date reminders, view your monthly consumption, etc.

**The City of Huxley highly encourages everyone to sign up for automatic withdrawal (using a checking account).** The form can be found on our website or stop by City Hall to pick one up. There is no fee for this service. Other payment options available include text to pay, autopay (using a credit card), cash, check or money order. Please note that fees apply for text to pay and autopay.

**Final Read Request:** If you move from Huxley, or to a different property in Huxley, you will need to complete the Final Read Request form found on our website. If not completed, all water and sewer usage will continue to be billed to you.

**Building Permits:** Before beginning any construction, be sure to check with City Hall regarding any permits you may need. For code specific questions please call our building inspector, Safe Building, at 515-333-4161. Permit applications can be emailed to [utilities@huxleyiowa.org](mailto:utilities@huxleyiowa.org).

**Severe Weather:** When there is a report of severe weather headed in the general direction of Huxley within a 30-mile radius, the following will happen:

1. The sirens that are located in town (one at Centennial Park, one at Nord Kalsem Park and one on the south end of Prairie Ridge) will be sounded and will continue to sound.
2. The City of Huxley does provide a shelter for those that do not have shelter of their own. The Safe Room, located on the north side of City Hall, will be unlocked when sirens are sounded or with the first sign of severe weather.
3. There will NOT be an "All Clear" signal given after the storm is over. Officers will stop by the Safe Room when it is safe to go home.

**Snow Removal:** After one inch of accumulated snow, parking on any city street in the City of Huxley is not allowed. The streets that are marked "Snow Route" will be the first streets plowed for safe travel. After the snow routes are plowed the remaining streets will be cleared in no particular order. Once the removal of snow has begun, police officers will start issuing citations to the vehicles left on the street. Citations will cost \$50.00. The vehicle also has a chance of being towed at the owner's expense.

**City Alerts:** Sign up for city alerts (snow ordinance, water main breaks, street closures, etc) delivered via text or email on our website.

**City Council:** City Council meetings are held at 6 PM on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month in the Council Chambers located at City Hall. Everyone is welcome. Emails of the elected officials can be found on our website.

**Notary Public:** Notary Public Officials are available at the Library and City Hall Monday through Friday, 8 AM to 4:30 PM. This service is free.

**Event Facilities:** Hosting an event? Wedding receptions, conferences, baby showers, reunions, etc. We have two affordable options. Consider Nord Kalsem Community Center or the Safe Room Conference Center. Details are listed on the Parks & Rec website (<https://huxleyiowa.org/parks-and-recreation/>). **Ballard Clothes & Food Pantry:** The Ballard Clothes Pantry is located at the corner of North Main St. and US Highway 69 at 602 N Main Avenue Suite 105. This service is free to anyone in the Ballard Community. Hours: Wednesday 5 PM – 7 PM. Appointments available by calling Jeriann McLaughlin at 515-291-3543. Donations are welcome.

**Huxley Public Library:** The Huxley Public Library is located on the second floor of the 3C's building. The library offers four public computers, fax/copy/print services, and two small meeting or study rooms. A large meeting room is also available and may be rented outside of regular library hours. The library provides thousands of titles for readers of all ages, along with a wide variety of programs for children, teens and adults. In addition, the library hosts a StoryWalk® along the Heart of Iowa Trail at Railroad Park. **Generations Fitness:** The Citizens Community Center (3C's) was established in February 2003. It is a 15,000-square foot community center that serves the City of Huxley as well as the Ballard community. Amenities include cardio and strength training equipment, indoor track, group exercises classes, a racquetball court and a full-size gymnasium. Rates, class schedules and programs are available on the City's website.

**Huxley Food Pantry:** The food pantry offers food as well as personal care items, paper products and cleaning supplies. It is located at 503 East 1<sup>st</sup> St behind the south Casey's. It is open Wednesday evenings from 6 PM to 7 PM. Questions? Please call any of the Huxley Churches.
