



## **New Hours for Hyde Convenience Sites**

Hyde County Convenience sites will observe changes in the New Year. Curbside collection will no longer be provided by the county and citizens will be responsible for transporting their solid waste to the convenience sites. Beginning Monday, January 2, 2012, the hours for convenience sites will be as follows:

### **Engelhard, Swan Quarter, Scranton and Fairfield**

**Hours of operation:** Sites are open Monday: 7 a.m. to noon; Tuesday - Wednesday: 7 a.m. to noon, 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.; Thursdays – Saturdays: 9 a.m. to noon, 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. and closed Sundays.

- Vegetative debris (trees, limbs, etc.)\*
- White goods (appliances, washer, dryers, etc.)
- Tires
- Recyclables (co-mingled)
- Household trash
- Scrap metal
- Used motor oil
- Construction and demolition debris

## **Ocracoke**

**Hours of operation:** Open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., seven days a week.

**Hours of operation:** Mondays, Wednesdays: 7 a.m. to noon, 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.; Saturdays: 9 a.m. to noon, 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.; Closed Sundays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

### **Items allowed:**

- White goods (appliances, washer, dryers, etc.)
- Tires
- Recyclables (co-mingled)
- Used motor oil
- Construction and demolition debris
- Wood pallets
- Batteries
- Household trash
- Scrap metal
