CAMPGROUND

CAMPING

- Basic - water only
- Standard - water and electric
- Group
- Check-in after 2 p.m., Check-out by 12 p.m.

VEHICLES

- Maximum of 2 vehicles in campsite at any time.
- One RV allowed per campsite; up to 3 tents.
- One vehicle included with campsite fee; additional vehicles will be charged an extra vehicle fee.
- All vehicles must be parked on asphalt and display a valid receipt.
- If a vehicle does not fit on the asphalt pad, it must be parked in the **visitor parking lot**, indicated on the map.

FIREWOOD

- Purchase at host sites A-6, B-3, C-51, and D-49.
- Available until 8 p.m.

FIRE PITS

- Wood must fit in fire pit.
- Please burn only wood — no trash, plastic or glass.

FOOD

Food should be stowed in secure containers. Squirrels and crows will tear through food and garbage bags.

PETS

- Pets must remain on a leash with a maximum length of six feet.
- Dog off leash area is located across from “C” loop entrance.
- Please **clean up** after your pet and **never leave pet unattended**.
- Waste bags and disposal containers are provided for your convenience near host sites in each camp loop.

TRASH & RECYCLING

A trash compactor is located by the dump station. Restroom receptacles are for restroom trash only. Recycle plastic and aluminum refundable cans and bottles in recycle boxes at entrance of each loop or by the trash compactor.

LAKE ACCESS

- The lake is **not** accessible from the campground.
- Follow the bike path between the campground and day-use area.
- The day-use area has a swim beach, boat ramp, and marina.
- Day-use area is open during daylight hours only and closes at dusk.

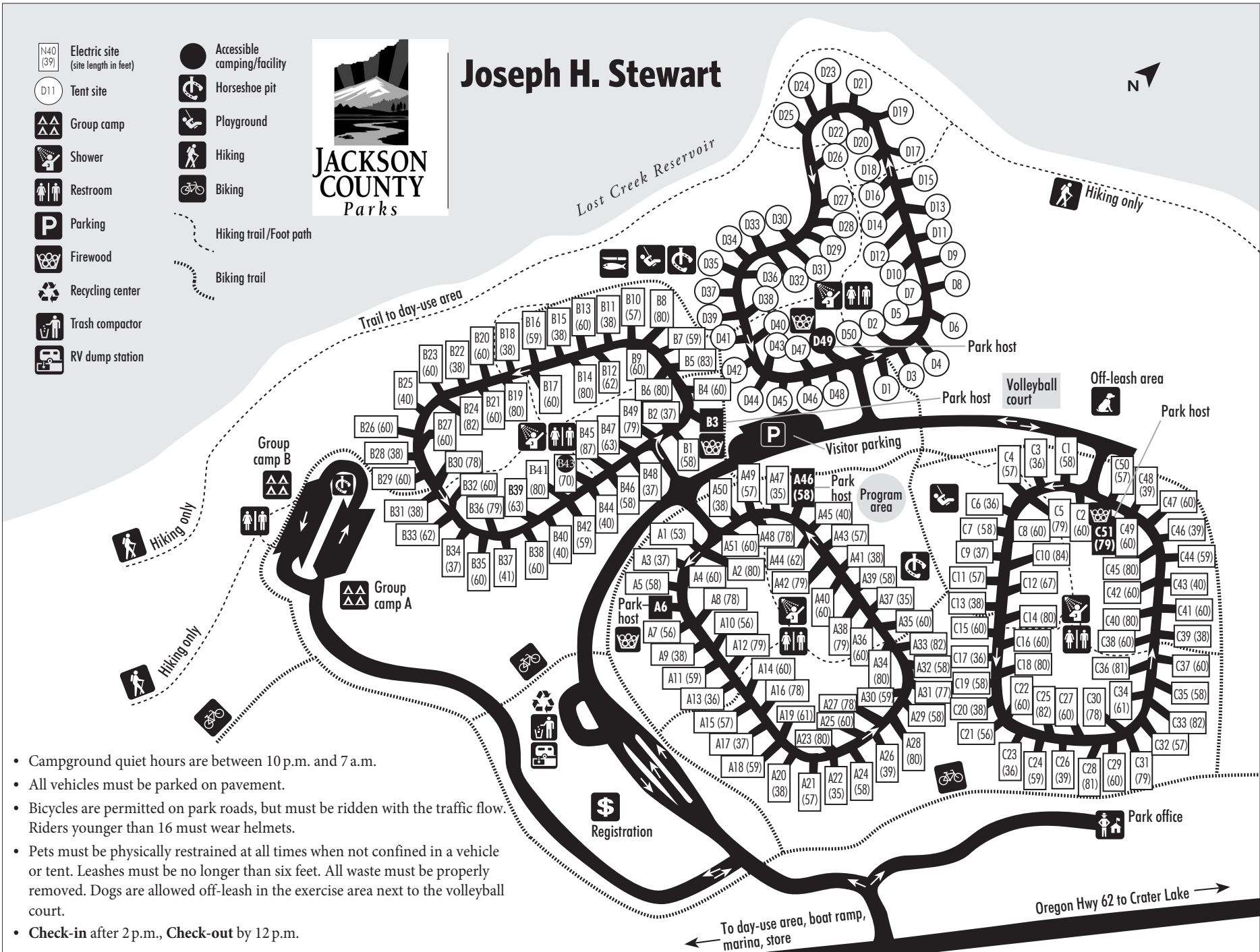

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
- Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but must be ridden with the traffic flow. Riders younger than 16 must wear helmets.
- Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed. Dogs are allowed off-leash in the exercise area next to the volleyball court.
