1072.01 EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE FOR PRISONERS.

- (a) Treatment Required. No person in the custody of any law enforcement officer shall be accepted for custody at the County Correctional Facility until any readily apparent condition requiring medical services has been treated.
- (b) Liability for Expenses. Liability for the expenses of providing emergency medical services is the responsibility of the recipient of such services and the public agency employing the law enforcement officer having custody of such person, as provided in ORS 169.166.
- (c) Authority and Scope. Subsections (c) through (e) hereof are adopted pursuant to the provisions of ORS 203.035 and apply to justice courts within Jackson County.
- (d) Purpose. The purpose of subsections (c) through (e) hereof is to ensure that sufficient funds will exist in the Oregon State Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account (LEMLA) to pay prisoner medical expenses at the time that the LEMLA becomes liable for such costs on July 1, 1992. Adequate funds will accrue only if justice courts collect and deposit designated County corrections assessment fees into the LEMLA, as circuit, district and municipal courts are required to do.

(e) Payment of Corrections Assessment Fees. The Justice of the Peace shall withhold and deposit to the treasury of the County receipts from assessments which have been dedicated to the Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account (LEMLA) as provided by 1991 Or Laws Ch 778' 5(4) (a). Such monies shall be forwarded by the County to the Oregon Department of Revenue for deposit in the LEMLA to pay prisoner medical expenses.

1072.02 PAYMENT OF PRISONERS FOR SERVICES.

Inmates in the County Jail will be reimbursed at the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per day for services performed as trustees on County work crews, which compensation shall be paid out of the County Sheriff's budget.
