**260.07 ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY COMMITTEES; DUTIES.**

There are hereby established in and for the County the following County Health and Human Services advisory committees:

- (a) The Jackson County Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee which shall serve as the local alcohol and drug planning committee for the County, as specified in ORS 430.342;
- (b) The Jackson County Mental Health and Development Disabilities Advisory Committee which shall serve as the local mental health and developmental disabilities advisory committee, as specified in ORS 430.630; and
- (c) The Jackson County Veterans Advisory Committee which shall serve as the local veteran's advisory committee providing recommendations and advice on current and future issues that could improve the Veteran Service Office.

**260.08 JACKSON COUNTY LOCAL ALCOHOL AND DRUG PLANNING COMMITTEE COMPOSITION; TERMS OF OFFICE, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

- (a) The Jackson County Local Alcohol and Drug Planning Committee shall consist of a minimum of nine and a maximum of thirteen members. Appointments shall be for a term of three years, commencing on June 30. Members shall:
  - (1) Be representative of the geographic area and be persons with interest or experience in developing programs dealing with alcohol and substance abuse problems;
  - (2) Include minority members that reasonably reflect the proportion of the need for alcoholism and substance abuse treatment and rehabilitation services of minorities in the community;
  - (3) Include, one member of the Jackson County Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Committee; and
  - (4) If possible, include one representative from the following: County Community Justice Department's Juvenile Program, local schools, a medical practitioner, and a non-medical psychotherapist.
- (b) If a member fails to attend more than three regular meetings, unexcused, in any one fiscal year, the Committee may, upon a majority vote, recommend to the Board that the office held by that member be declared vacant and that a replacement be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

(c) The Committee shall identify needs and establish priorities for alcohol and drug prevention and treatment services that best suit the needs and values of the community and report its findings and make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners.

(d) The Committee shall hold regular meetings at least once quarterly, with the frequency, time and place to be established by the Committee members in accordance with needs of each Committee and at the request of the Board of County Commissioners.

(e) The Committee shall organize and select officers.

**260.09 JACKSON COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE COMPOSITION; TERMS OF OFFICE, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

(a) The Jackson County Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Committee membership shall consist of a minimum of nine and a maximum of fifteen members. Appointments shall be for a term of three years, commencing on June 30. Members shall:

- (1) Be broadly representative of the community with the balance of age, sex, ethnic, socioeconomic, geographic, professional and consumer interests represented, including the consumer interests of alcoholism, alcohol abuse, emotional disturbances, drug abuse, mental retardation and other developmental disabilities; and
- (2) For at least three of the members, have experience receiving mental health services themselves or members of their families.

(b) If a member fails to attend more than three regular meetings, unexcused, in any one fiscal year, the Committee may, upon a majority vote, recommend to the Board that the office held by that member be declared vacant and that a replacement be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

(c) The Committee shall advise the Board of County Commissioners on matters of public concern relating the mental health and developmental disabilities services offered in the County.

(d) The Committee shall hold regular meetings at least once quarterly, with the frequency, time and place to be established by the Committee members in accordance with needs of each Committee and at the request of the Board of County Commissioners.

(e) The Committee shall organize and select officers.

**260.10 JACKSON COUNTY VETERANS ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
COMPOSITION; TERMS OF OFFICE; FUNCTIONS AND  
RESPONSIBILITIES.**

(a) The Jackson County Veterans Advisory Committee membership shall consist of a minimum of nine and a maximum of eleven members. Appointments shall be for a term of 2 years. Members be veterans, representatives of veteran organizations, civic leaders, dependents of veterans, and survivors of veterans.

(b) If a member fails to attend more than three regular meetings, unexcused, in any one fiscal year, the Committee may, upon a majority vote, recommend to the Board that the office held by that member be declared vacant and that a replacement be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

(c) The Committee shall provide the Board of County Commissioners, the County Administrator, and the Director of County Health and Human Services with recommendations and advice on issues concerning services to veterans, and dependents and survivors of veterans.

(d) The Committee shall hold regular meetings at least once quarterly, with the frequency, time and place to be established by the Committee members in accordance with needs of each Committee and at the request of the Board of County Commissioners.

(e) The Committee shall organize and select officers.
