

CHAPTER 882
Tax for Fire Patrol on Private Forest Lands

EDITOR'S NOTE: Upon certification by the Office of the State Forester to the Board of County Commissioners of the budgeted cost for providing forest patrol services for fire protection on private forest lands in the County, the Board levies a tax and directs the County Assessor and the County Tax Collector to assess and collect the same and directs the County Treasurer to pay it to the Office of the State Forester, pursuant to ORS 477.270.

Copies of the latest relevant legislation may be obtained, at cost, from the Office of the County Counsel.
