System went down due to UPS Power failure. Gencomm will be working to get things updated. Still working to fix issues that are out there.

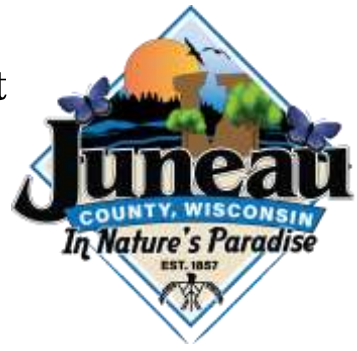
