New Developments: Jack reported on new Necedah taxi and questioned if would participate in Ride Share Program.

Tom said he obtained information from Weiland at Highway Department about a sign on Highway G warning about 10th Street.

Highway 80 boat landing sign at Harvey Street, Jack said there is no new information.

Cranberry Creek Mounds: Ray could not get new information about the new Juneau County website.

Ray reported that Tamaya Loewe put the Juneau County Visitor Guide on the current website and the website committee indicated the Visitor Guide would be on new website.

For the Union Center canoe launch, Ray reported that the American Legion needed to provide a general easement or 25 year easement to county to be able to apply for a DNR grant. Wisconsin was allotted \$46.8 million for DNR funding from Federal funds.
