Present were Ray Feldman, Jack Jasinski and Tom Winters. Ray called the meeting to order. Motion to approve minutes of January 3, 2023, was made by Jack Jasinski, motion approved unanimously.

New Developments:

Jack questioned what the new business is being set up on Highway 80 near 58 split south of Necedah. Tom Winters thought it looked like a new landscaping business.

Ray reported on Friends of the Baraboo River meeting held by zoom on February 6.

Tom reported the Sprague-Mather town road west of Highway 80 was closed because of a collapsed culvert. Neither Tom nor Jack had any information how long the road would be closed.

No one had any new information about the Highway 80 boat landing sign at Harvey Street in Necedah. Highway G sign by 10th Street CAUTION sign: Tom talked to Randy Weiland at the County Public Works Dept. who seemed to understand the traffic problem. Ray talked to Roy Granger Chairman of the Highway & Public Works Committee about the same. No promises were made about correcting the problem and so it was decided to check back with Weiland and Granger in March.

Juneau County Website Design: Ray reported that at last meeting only a logo was decided upon.

Visitor Guide: Tamaya Loewe said a prototype should be available in February to review.

Next meeting was set for March 7 at 2:00 at Necedah Library. Ray declared the meeting closed. The committee then went on about an hour tour of the Necedah Pallet Factory.
