Present were Ray Feldman, Jack Jasinski and Tom Winters. Ray called the meeting to order. Motion to approve minutes of December 6, 2022, was made by Jack Jasinski, motion approved unanimously.

Jack Jasinski reported an effort to get Juneau County Public Works to install a 'Boat Landing' sign at Harvey Street in Necedah.

Ray Feldman reported on progress of Juneau County website design committee and efforts of every department to have their own space on the new site.

Tom Winter discussed the need for a 'Boat Landing' sign north of Necedah on Highway G at the intersection of 10th Street. Tom felt that a sign is needed on Highway G about ¼ mile before the intersection with 10th Street so people pulling campers to go to Wilderness Park and boaters slow down soon enough to safely make the corner.

Ray reported that the Juneau County Visitor Guide is being prepared and hopefully can be also on the new website.

The Central Sands Dairy bankruptcy was discussed and what it will mean for the lawsuit with farmers. Tom reported that all the buildings are closed to the public and manure is being hauled away.

Jack said he would try to line up a tour of the reopened Necedah Pellet Factory.
