INTRODUCED BY: Human Service Board

SYNOPSIS: Approving and Authorizing a Comprehensive Community Services Program in the Department of Human Services

FISCAL NOTE: No additional payroll or workforce costs, and the County should benefit financially in grants available to it in connection with implementation of the program.

WHEREAS, the Juneau County Department of Human Services will apply for and receive Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) program certification from the State of Wisconsin, and said program has been tried and tested successfully in many other counties throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the CCS program allows billing of Medical Assistance for important and needed psychosocial rehabilitation services, such as counseling and medication management related to mental health issues and addiction problems, which will be reimbursed by Medical Assistance at 60% to 100% of the cost; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain a Medical Assistance billing provider number for the CCS program, the County must agree to make available the non-federal share needed to provide Medical comprehensive community services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Juneau County Board of Supervisors shall and hereby does approve of, and authorize the Department of Human Services to participate in, the Comprehensive Community Services program and hereby agrees to make available and provide the non-federal share needed to provide Medicaid comprehensive community services to County residents as required to receive a billing provider number and qualify for purposes of reimbursement.
