Purpose of Sale:

Unit A is thinning for the purpose to reduce stand stocking and promote growth and forest health of the residual stems post-harvest.

Cutting Specifications:

Unit A – Thinning. Cut all trees marked in orange paint. 69 acres.

Access:

Property can currently be accessed by Snow Mobile/UTV/ATV trails located off both HWY 58 and County Rd G.

Special Operating Requirements and Slash Disposal:

1. There are no seasonal restrictions to the timber sale.
2. The sale harvest boundaries are marked in red paint, and the boundaries to other ownership are marked in blue paint. Do not cut trees marked in red or blue paint.
3. All pine products cut between March 1st and August 30th must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting to control bark beetle populations. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed before March 15th.
4. All roads and trails used by logging equipment should be left in condition satisfactory to DNR Forester or School District of Mauston.
5. Slash must be evenly lopped/scattered within the sale boundary and shall be deposited a minimum of 10 feet from the mowed right-of-way of any highway, town road, or recreational trail. Slash within 50 feet of all town roads and recreational trails must lie within 2 feet of the ground. Do not bury seedlings or saplings with slash.
6. **The pine stands are located within the 25-mile Heterobasidial Root Disease (Annosum) area, and require stump treatment unless harvested between December 1 and March 31. Treatment must be performed by a Certified Pesticide Applicator. Treatment involves chemically treating all fresh-cut stumps of pines of merchantable size by applying either CELLU-TREAT (disodium octaborate tetrahydrate) or Rotstop C (biological fungicide). Treatment shall be made as soon as possible and no later than one day after harvest and a dye product shall be added to liquid solutions for inspection purposes. The cost of this application can vary based on application method and harvest conditions, but should be considered when submitting bids on these timber sales. All pine stumps must be treated for HRD.**

General Requirements:

1. All landings and new roads must be approved by a DNR forester or School District of Mauston before operations begin.
2. All designated tree species must be cut and forwarded concurrently with the sale.
3. All stumps shall be no higher than the stump diameter, or 10 inches, whichever is less.
4. An effort to mitigate damage to dead standing and snags within the harvest area must be taken.
5. Utilization: cut and use all designated trees with one or more 100" sticks to a 4" top diameter.
6. Notify the Mauston School District before you start the job, and each time you pull out or return to the job.
7. Any berms removed during harvesting operations must be put back to the satisfaction of the School District of Mauston.
8. Any trees cut or pushed over for new roads or landings must be utilized or cleared to the School District of Mauston's satisfaction.
9. Contractor must avoid **powerline along ROW** of HWY 58.
10. Proper signage for logging activities for both the Snow Mobile/UTV/ATV trails plus state highway and County Rd G maybe required based on project timing as well as the discretion of the School District of Mauston.
11. **Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Invasive Species applies – contractor must clean equipment before entering and leaving the sale area! This involves brushing away all dirt and cleaning air intakes of debris.**

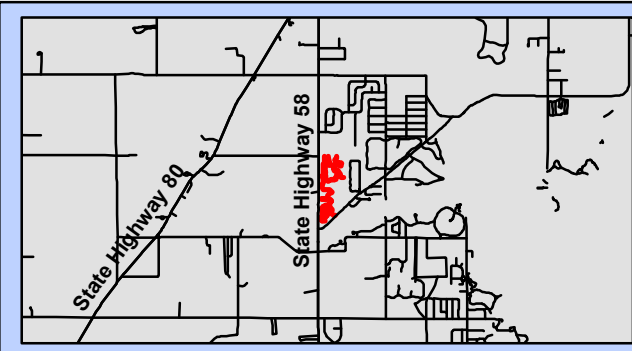
