

Dear Kaibab Members,

I am pleased to share some exciting developments and updates regarding our community initiatives and economic ventures.

Firstly, we have submitted the Grid Resilience Grant application to the Department of Energy (DOE). This grant, which has been non-competitive and allocated specifically to our Band for the past few years, amounts to \$248,584 this cycle. We are considering using these funds to enhance our community's infrastructure by purchasing battery storage capacity. The installation is tentatively planned for either the Community Building or the Elders Building, although the exact location will be finalized later. Rest assured, the grant terms offer us flexibility to make the best decision as plans develop.

In retail news, exciting changes are underway at Red Cliffs Chevron. If you've visited recently, you might have noticed the new Beer Cave among other enhancements. Ronnie and Isaac have been diligently working on re-arranging the store and broadening our product offerings. Additionally, starting Monday, May 13th, store hours will be extended to accommodate the seasonal influx of visitors with the North Rim's business period. The new hours will be Monday to Saturday from 6 AM to 10 PM, and Sunday from 7 AM to 7 PM.

Furthermore, the RV Park is gearing up for a promotional event scheduled for May 31st to June 1st. Jessi has made vendor spots available at no cost to tribal members. This is a wonderful opportunity for those interested in showcasing their products or services. Please email rvpark@kaibabaiute-nsn.gov to reserve your spot or for more information.

The tribal administration and Providence Trust rely on the Tribal Trust office to keep the addresses up to date. Both the Adult Per Capita form and the Minor Per Capita form can be found on the tribe's website: kaibabpaiutensn.gov.

This is also the form to update the amount of taxes are taken out of each per capita payment. #8 on the form specifically addresses tax withholding.

Please submit the Per Capita form before the 17<sup>th</sup> of the month we are receiving our per capita payment so that I can assure you that the changes made will apply to the current payment.
