

Opt-In to City of Kenton Electrical Aggregation Program

The city of Kenton has negotiated an electrical rate of \$0.0561 per kWh until May of 2025. Below are the directions on how to identify your current supplier and how to opt-in to the city's negotiated rate.

Usage Details:

1. Identify current energy supplier. Identify current energy charge. Rate negotiated by city is \$0.0561 per kWh until May 2025

2. To get out of current supplier call number listed on bill. Be aware that an early termination fee may apply. This often takes a couple of billing cycles to be completed.

3. Call 1-866-636-3749 and ask to opt-in with the City of Kenton's Electric Aggregation Program. The rate should be \$0.0561 per kWh until May 2025. You will need to know your service delivery identifier number. You will also have to listen to terms and conditions questions at the end of the call.
