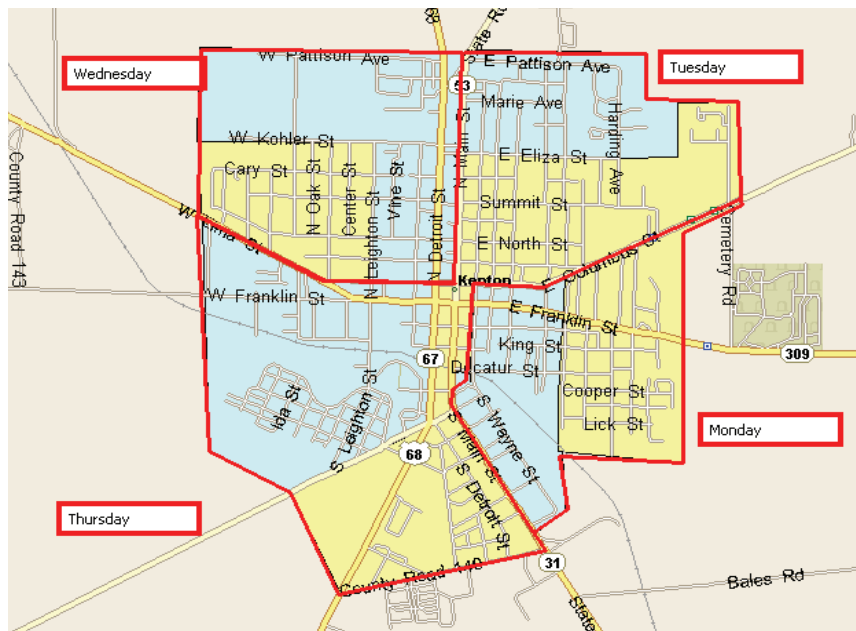
Locate your service area on the map below to determine if you are an A Week customer or a B Week customer. Reference the calendar to determine if your **recycling** is to be collected on an A Week or B Week.

Trash is collected every week and should be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day. Recyclables are collected every other week and should be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day.

Holidays are marked in orange and may cause your collections to be postponed 1 business day.

- All residents of Kenton living in 3 units or less will be participating in this recycling and trash collection service. The cost will be included on your monthly water and sewer bill.
- All residents will receive a 96-gallon trash cart and a 65-gallon recycling cart. The carts are assigned to each home and, if removed from the property, will incur a charge of \$70.
- Trash collection will be every week on the same schedule as your current collection day. Please set the cart out at the curb prior to 6 a.m. on your collection day. All trash must be bagged prior to placing it in the cart.
- Residents can place their trash cart and up to 3 additional 30-gallon bags at the curb each week.
- One bulk item per week can also be set out. No items should be over 50 lbs. and all appliances containing Freon® must be tagged that the Freon has been removed properly. Wrap mattresses and box springs with plastic and seal with tape.
- Recycling can be set out every other week on the schedule marked on the calendar. Acceptable items must be broken down and placed in the cart. No recyclables will be collected if outside the cart.
- The 6 major holidays could delay collection 1 business day. Please reference the calendar inside this brochure.
- Set carts at the curb with handles facing your house. Carts should not be under limbs, wires or structures and should be at least 3 feet from mailboxes or other carts and cans. Trash carts can be placed on opposite sides of your driveway.
- Please follow the list of acceptable and unacceptable items.
