



## *Residential Fence Permit Quick Facts*

- Permits are required to install fences and walls in the City of LaBelle. This applies to residential fences, as well as fences associated with commercial, industrial and other non-residential uses.
- You must complete the City permit form, provide a survey/diagram of the proposed fence location, and submit the application fee.
- In front/street yards of residential lots, fences and walls are limited to 4ft in height, and must be finished wood (split rail, picket, decorative post), metal, vinyl, brick, stucco, pre-cast concrete, or similar material. *Chain link fences are not permitted in front yards.*
- Fences and walls made of unfinished wood, chicken wire, tires, wood pallets, or other non-traditional materials are prohibited.
- In the side and rear yards of residential lots, fences and walls may be a maximum of 8ft in height. The only exception is 8ft tall fences and walls are permitted in the secondary front yards on corner lots, but the fence/wall cannot extend beyond the architectural front of the principal structure/house.
- Fences and walls may not obstruct the visibility triangles/sight distance triangles.
- Except for decorative post and split rail, fences and walls shall be installed with the structural supports facing inside the subject property and the finished surface facing adjacent properties and public rights-of-way.
