The meeting of the City Council of the City of Ladue, St. Louis County, Missouri, was held on Friday September 22nd, 2023, at 8:00 a.m., via Zoom. The following members were present:

Approval of the Agenda: Council Member Fox moved to approve the agenda as presented, upon second by Council Member Hensley the motion passed unanimously.

Public Hearings:

PH1: The City Council will hold a public hearing at which citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the City of Ladue

Council Member Burroughs moved to open the public hearing, with second by Council Member Hensley the motion passed unanimously.

Director of Finance, Scott Kroenung, reviewed the proposed tax rates for 2023 which included a decrease from 0.9060 to 0.8470 for residential property, and an increase for commercial property to 0.5810, up from 0.5340 in 2022. There were no changes to personal property or agricultural.

Mayor Spewak asked if there was anyone from the public who wished to comment. No one wished to comment.

Council Member Burroughs moved to close the public hearing, with second by Council Member Hensley the motion passed unanimously.

New Business:
Proposed Legislation:

Bill 2348: An ordinance establishing the rate of taxes to be levied and collected to support the operating budget for the fiscal period January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

Mayor Spewak read Bill No. 2348 followed by a second reading by Council Member Fox.


Council Member Fox moved for approval of Bill No. 2348. Upon second by Council Member Hensley the roll call vote thereupon was as follows:

Council Member Howell	"Aye"


There being five aye votes and zero nay votes the motion passed unanimously.
