AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAMESA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1.08, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LAMESA, TEXAS, ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATION" REGARDING IMPOSITION OF FEES FOR USE OF THE ADULT SOFTBALL FIELD

On the 16TH day of May, 2017, there came on and was held at the City Hall of the City of Lamesa, Texas, an open meeting of the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, held pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act (Texas Government Code, Chapter 551), there being a quorum present and acting throughout the meeting, the following ordinance was formally submitted by motion and duly seconded for the consideration and action of the meeting, to-wit:

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Article 1.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lamesa, Texas, should be amended to provide for the imposition of fees for use of the Adult Softball Field.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMESA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Article 1.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lamesa, Texas, be, and is hereby, amended by adding Section 1.08.006 "Park Fees" For the Adult Softball Field:

§ 1.08.006 (c) Fees For Use of the Adult Softball Field

League Play

- Fee for Usage: \$350 per season per league. Must pay in full before use.
- Refundable deposit: \$275 per season per league. Refundable deposit can be retained by City for damage to the facility, fences, equipment and/or for prohibited conduct (i.e. fighting, etc.) as determined by the City Manager.
- \$50 fee to prep the field for a tournament (1x only per tournament). Teams responsible for up keep of fields for other games during tournament.

Tournament Play

Non-Profit Entity:

- \$150 per day fee for use of the field, plus refundable deposit of \$275. Refundable deposit can be retained by City for damage to the facility, fences, equipment and/or for prohibited conduct (i.e. fighting, etc.) as determined by the City Manager.
- \$50 cost to prep the field for a tournament (1x). Teams responsible for up keep for other games in tournament.

Private Tournament:

- \$150 per day fee for use of the field, plus refundable deposit of \$275. Refundable deposit can be retained by City for damage to the facility, fences, equipment and/or for prohibited conduct (i.e. fighting, etc.) as determined by the City Manager.
- \$50 cost to prep the field for a tournament (1x). Teams responsible for up keep for other games in tournament.

SECTION 2. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be May 26, 2017.

SECTION 3. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish the descriptive caption of this ordinance in the manner and for the length of time prescribed by Article IV, Section 24 of the City Charter and state law.

ORDINANCE NO:

AN ORDINANCE DENYING A ZONE CHANGE FOR WEST 50 OF LOT 7 BLOCK 22 OF THE HILLCREST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LAMESA, DAWSON COUNTY, TEXAS FROM DISTRICT R-1 (SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) BUT GRANTING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT TO ALLOW PLACEMENT OF A MANUFACTURED HOME ON SUCH PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1304 SOUTH 14TH STREET, LAMESA, TEXAS UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

On this the 16th day of May, 2017, there came on and was held at the regular meeting place, the City Hall, an open meeting of the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, held pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, and there being a quorum present and acting throughout the meeting, the following ordinance was formally submitted by motion and duly seconded for the consideration and action of the meeting, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lamesa provides that the zoning districts of said city may be changed upon application of the property owner and upon recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City; and

WHEREAS, an application to the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Lamesa, Texas, has been made to change the zoning of the following described property located at 1304 South 14th Street, Lamesa, Texas, from a District R-1 (Single-family Residential) to allow placement of a manufactured home on the following described property, to-wit:

West/50 of Lot 7 Block 22 of the Hillcrest Addition to the City of Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, said property is located within the city limits of the City of Lamesa, Texas, located at 1304 South 14th Street, and is within a district zoned as R-1 (Single-family residential); and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Lamesa, Texas, after hearing such application and the arguments for and against the same, has voted to recommend to the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, that such request for a change in the zoning of such property be denied, but that a specific use permit to allow the placement of a manufactured home on such property be granted; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing, where all interested persons were provided with an opportunity to be heard on the proposed zone change was held at City Hall, 601 South First Street, in the City of Lamesa, Texas, on May 23rd, 2017, which date is not less than fifteen days prior to the publication of a notice of such hearing in the Lamesa Press-Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lamesa, Texas;

WHEREAS, after such hearing, the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, finds that the use for which such zone change is sought will not be injurious to the neighborhood or otherwise detrimental to the public interest and welfare and will be in harmony with the general purpose of the Zoning Ordinances of the City of Lamesa, Texas, and that the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Lamesa, Texas, should be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMESA, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE: That the request to change the zoning of the following described property located at 1304 South 14th Street, Lamesa, Texas, from a District R-1 (Single-family Residential) to allow the placement of a manufactured home on the following described property, to-wit:

West/50 of Lot 7 Block 22 of the Hillcrest Addition to the City of Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas; and

be **Denied**, but that a **specific use permit** to allow the placement of a manufactured home on such property be, and is hereby, **Granted**.

SECTION TWO: The provisions of this ordinance are to be cumulative and shall constitute an amendment to the zoning ordinance of the City of Lamesa, Texas, only as it applies to the hereinabove described property.

SECTION THREE: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION FOUR: The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish the descriptive caption of this ordinance in the manner and for the length of time prescribed by Article IV, Section 24 of the City Charter and State law.

Upon being put to a vote, the foregoing ordinance was Passed, on First Reading on the 16th day of May, 2017, by a majority vote; and then on the 23rd day of May, 2017, there came on and will be held at the regular meeting place, the City Hall, an open meeting of the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, held pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, and there being a quorum present and acting throughout the meeting, the foregoing ordinance was formally submitted by motion and duly seconded for the consideration and action of the meeting, and upon being put to a vote, the foregoing ordinance was Passed on Second and Final Reading and Adopted this 23rd day of May, 2017, by a majority vote and ordered to be spread upon the minutes of the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas, and recorded in the ordinance book thereafter.

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE FOR THE 2017 CITY OF LAMESA SPECIAL ELECTION.

On this the 23rd day of May, 2017, there came on and was held at the regular meeting place, the City Hall, an open meeting of the City Council of the City of Lamesa, Texas held pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act; there being a quorum present and acting throughout the meeting, the following resolution was formally submitted by motion and duly seconded for the consideration and action of the meeting, to wit:

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Lamesa, Texas, provide that on August 19, 2017, there shall be elected the following officials for this City:

One (1) "Council Member" District 3; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Lamesa, Texas and the terms of the Federal Court Order resolving Civil Action Number CA 5-91-0153 further provide that the Election Code of the State of Texas is applicable to said election, and in order to comply with said Code, a resolution and order should be passed establishing the procedure to be followed in said election, and designating the voting place for said election; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare that said resolution be passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMESA, TEXAS:

That an election be held on the 19th day of August, 2017, for the purpose of electing:

One (1) "Council Member" District 3; and

That all independent candidates at said election file their applications to become candidates with the City Secretary at City Hall, 601 South First, Lamesa, Texas on or before five o'clock P.M. on the sixty second day before the election, that day being the 20th day of June, 2017, and that all of said applications shall be on a form as prescribed by Section 141.031 of the Election Code of the State of Texas; and

That the order in which the names of the candidates are to be printed on the ballot shall be determined by a drawing by the City Secretary as provided by Section 52.094 of the Election Code; that drawing to be held at nine o'clock A.M. on the 22nd day of June, 2017; and

That said election shall be held at the following place in said City:

Forrest Park Community Center 814 South Houston Avenue Lamesa, Texas; and

That the polling place listed above shall be open from seven o'clock A.M. until seven o'clock P.M. on election day; and

Early voting shall also be conducted at City Hall, 601 South First, Lamesa, Texas in the office of the City Secretary and said place of early voting shall remain open during the hours that the secretary's office is regularly open for business, which is not a Saturday, a Sunday or an official State Holiday. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted as follows:

DateWeekdayTimesAugust 2 thru August 11(Wednesday thru Friday)8 am - 5 pmAugust 14 and August 15(Monday and Tuesday)7 am - 7 pm

The City of Lamesa will be using the ES&S AutoMARK voter assist terminal. This AutoMARK is an optical scan ballot marking system designed to provide privacy and accessibility to voters who are visually impaired, or have a disability or condition that would make it difficult or impossible to mark a ballot in the usual way. In addition, the technology provides language assistance to voters who are more comfortable speaking an alternative language or who have reading difficulties.

That early voting by personal appearance for said designated election shall be at City Hall, 601 South First, Lamesa, Texas, in the office of the City Secretary and said place of early voting shall remain open during the hours that the secretary's office is regularly open for business, which is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official State Holiday, beginning on the 17th day before and continuing through the 4th day preceding the date of said election; and

The applications for ballot by mail shall be mailed to the Office of the City Secretary, 601 South First, Lamesa, Texas 79331. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on the 8th day of August, 2017; and

That all early voting ballots cast in said election shall be counted by an Early Voting Ballot Board in accordance with the provisions of Section 87.001 of the Election Code; and that said Early Voting Ballot Board shall be appointed by the city council. The early voting ballots shall be counted separately from the ballots cast in that polling place and a separate set of records be prepared for them; and

That said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of this State; and only qualified voters being residents of said City shall be eligible to vote at said election; and

That the Mayor shall give notice of this election in accordance with the terms and provisions of Chapter 4 of the Election Code; said notice shall be published in the Lamesa Press-Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lamesa, Texas, not later than the tenth day before election day and posted in the City Hall at 601 South First not later than the 21st day before election day; and that such notice shall be recorded and preserved in accordance with the provisions of Section 4.005 of the Election Code; and

That the Mayor shall issue all necessary orders and writs for said election and returns of said election shall be made to the Council immediately after the closing of the polls; and







Warranty Statement

1.00 NEW VEHICLE COVERAGE

The following section outlines Company standard warranty coverages for all Company vehicles, apparatus or chassis or cabs sold and domiciled in the USA (50 states and Washington, D.C.), Puerto Rico, and Canada. This information is also included in the Operator's Maintenance and Owner's Warranty Information Booklet.

1.01 NEW VEHICLE LIMITED WARRANTY

Under this New Vehicle Limited Warranty ("Warranty"), Company warrants that each new vehicle will be free from defects in material and workmanship that occur under normal use within the applicable warranty period, subject to certain limitations and exclusions as specified in this document,

This Warranty covers all components and parts unless specifically covered by other warranties or otherwise excluded by this document.

1.02 LIMITATIONS

This Warranty does not apply to vehicles that are sold or domiciled outside of the United States (50 states and Washington, D.C.), Puerto Rico, or Canada.

This Warranty does not apply to engines, Allison or Twin Disc transmissions, tires, or other components or parts that are not manufactured by Company and that are warranted directly by their respective manufacturers, With respect to the foregoing, Company makes no warranty whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise including, but not limited to, any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

THIS WARRANTY IS EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND WHETHER WRITTEN, ORAL, OR IMPLIED INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. THIS WARRANTY SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES ANY OTHER WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS PROVIDED FOR BY LAW, WHETHER STATUTORY OR OTHERWISE.

COMPANY'S SOLE OBLIGATION UNDER THIS WARRANTY SHALL BE TO REPAIR OR REPLACE, IN COMPANY 'S SOLE DISCRETION, ANY DEFECTIVE COMPONENT OR PART, SUCH REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT SHALL BE WITHOUT COST TO PURCHASER WHEN PERFORMED WITHIN THE APPLICABLE WARRANTY PERIOD (TIME, DISTANCE, OR HOUR LIMIT, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST). Purchaser must notify Company within the applicable warranty period, of any failure of the vehicle to comply with this Warranty and Purchaser must, at Purchaser's expense, promptly return the vehicle to an authorized Dealer for inspection and repair or replacement of any defect in material or workmanship occurring within the applicable

The vehicle must be maintained and serviced according to the prescribed schedules outlined in the Driver's/Operator's and Maintenance Manuals, Receipted bills and other evidence that required maintenance and service have been performed are required by Company as a condition of this Warranty.

After the Company's obligations under this Warranty expire, all liabilities of Company to Purchaser under this Warranty shall terminate, Repairs made under this Warranty do not constitute an extension of the original Warranty period for the vehicle or for any specific component or part.

To the extent that any provision of this Warranty contravenes the law of any jurisdiction, such provision shall be inapplicable in such jurisdiction, and the remainder of the warranty shall not be affected.

1.03 PURCHASER'S EXCLUSIVE REMEDY

THIS WARRANTY SHALL BE THE PURCHASER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AGAINST COMPANY, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, UNDER STATUTE (INCLUDING STATUTORY PROVISIONS AS TO CONDITIONS AS TO QUALITY OR FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE OF GOODS SUPPLIED PURSUANT TO THE CONTRACT OF SALE), WARRANTY, TORT, STRICT LIABILITY, OR ANY OTHER LEGAL THEORY.

1.04 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

COMPANY'S LIABILITY UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS LIMITED TO THE COST TO REPAIR OR REPLACE, IN COMPANY'S SOLE DISCRETION, THE DEFECTIVE COMPONENT OR PART THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL EXCEED THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE VEHICLE AT THE TIME THE DEFECT IS DISCOVERED.

IN NO EVENT SHALL COMPANY BE LIABLE FOR SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INJURIES TO PERSONS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, LOSS OF PROFITS OR ANTICIPATED PROFITS, OR LOSS OF VEHICLE USE.

Coverage Descriptions

Coverage includes all factory-installed steer axles; drive axles; tag axles; and pusher axles, Excludes any axle installed by a dealer or body builder.

Drive Axle(s)

Coverage includes axle housing, carrier assembly, differential assembly, power divider, axle shafts, and gaskets and seals. Excludes suspension and torque rod brackets, tie rod ends, wheel end equipment, wiring, yokes, and attaching hardware.

Pusher Axle

A pusher axle is a non-driven, weight-bearing axle that can be raised when not required to bear a portion of the load. Since the pusher axle can be of many different configurations, warranty coverage includes all components included in the individual build specification of each individual application.

Steer Axle

Coverage includes I-beam, steering knuckles, differential on drive steer axle, spindles, kingpins, kingpin bearings and steering arms. Excludes wheel end equipment, tie rod ends, steering linkage components, kingpin bushings, and king pin seals.

Tag Axle

A tag axle is a non-driven, continuous weight-bearing axle. Since the tag axle can be of many different configurations, warranty coverage includes all components included in the individual build specification of each individual application.

Battery

Only Freightliner LLC's private brand-label (Alliance Brand Parts), Mopar (Sterling Bullet only), and Furukawa [STL360 Model only] batteries will be warranted. Any other brand of battery is excluded from Company coverage. Claims for all other brands must be submitted directly to the supplier. Warranty coverage includes the battery assembly only.

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Basic Body

Coverage includes body emergency lighting and controls; hinged and rollup compartment doors; body trim; body and controls; body electrical systems.

Basic Chassis

Coverage includes all factory-installed components of the vehicle/chassis that are not excluded elsewhere in the warranty, or by special agreement or described as having a different time, or distance or hours, or listed separately on each new vehicle warranty coverage chart.

Basic Vehicle

Coverage includes all factory-installed components of the vehicle/chassis that are not excluded elsewhere in the warranty, or by special agreement or described as having a different time or distance, or listed separately on each

Body Electrical


