**AD VALOREM TAX RATE** – **2019:** Consider establishing an ad valorem tax rate for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 by passing on second reading an ordinance establishing the ad valorem tax rate of **\$0.834607** per hundred dollar assessed valuation for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020, and adopting the provisions of Section 31.05 of the State Property Tax Code to provide for discounts under certain conditions. *(City Manager)*
