

THAT THIS IS EVIDENCE IN WRITING of a Contract of Bargain and Sale entered into this day by and between Lamesa Economic Development Corporation, Texas non-profit corporation, whose mailing address is 123 Main Avenue, Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas, herein called "Seller", and 1 SAM 1, LLC, the mailing address of which is 106 Highland Drive, Lamesa, Texas 79331, hereafter called "Buyer".

### WITNESSETH:

1. PROPERTY: Seller is the owner of all of that real property located in Dawson County, Texas, (the "Property") which Seller hereby agrees to sell to Buyer, and Buyer hereby agrees to purchase, on the terms and conditions hereafter set forth, the Property being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of Lots 10 and 11, Block 24, of the Original Town of Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas;

SUBJECT TO all valid, existing mineral reservations and conveyances and easements and rights-of-way, if any, affecting said property of record in the Office of the County Clerk of Dawson County, Texas.

- 2. CONSIDERATION: The total consideration to be paid for the Property is the sum of \$5,000.00, to be paid in cash by Buyer to Seller at the time this transaction is closed.
- 3. TITLE: At the time this transaction is closed, Seller shall furnish to Buyer, at Seller's expense, a policy of owner's title insurance written by a reputable title insurance company, with said policy to insure good and indefeasible fee simple title to the Property in question in the Buyer in at least the amount of the consideration specified herein, and subject only to those matters which are contained in this contract. Within a reasonable time after the execution of this contract and prior to the closing of this transaction, Seller shall cause a title commitment for an owner's policy of title insurance to be issued and furnished to Buyer. Buyer shall have a reasonable time after the receipt of

such commitment in which to examine the commitment. If the commitment contains any exceptions or title defects other than the standard exceptions normally found in title insurance policies, any present liens which will be released prior to or contemporaneously with closing, or easement or right-of-way exceptions which constitute easements which are not actually visible on the ground, then Buyer shall notify Seller in writing of such objections to title. If Buyer approves the title commitment or if Seller agrees, in writing, to cure any title objections by Buyer, then this Contract will be in full force and effect. Thank you for contacting me on Friday. Below is some more information on the proposed move of the Lamesa Mesonet station (weather station) to the South Houston Street area. Thanks. Wes

We currently have a West Texas Mesonet station on the southeast corner of the Lamesa landfill. We would like to move the station to a proposed location off South Houston Street beside the communication tower in a native ground/mesquite region (west of the tower at 32.717886, - 101.951741). The expansion of Hwy 349 and the landfill are causing wind and temperature problems at the existing location. The footprint and dimensions of the new station would be the same as the existing station.

The mesonet station has a 33-ft tall tower with a 32 by 32-ft fenced-in area. All sensors and guy wires fit inside the fenced-in area. We use solar power to run all the sensors and there is no cost to the city. We have a cell modem at the station to retrieve 29 different weather and agricultural parameters for the public to use. We dig down 30 inches to install soil moisture sensor and there is a small 28 inches by 28 inches concrete pad for the tower base. There is no RF equipment on the mesonet station that will impact any communication platforms on the county/city tower.

Texas Tech and National Weather Service folks will build the new station. If the city or county could scape a small area of mesquite away from around the new location, that would be great.


