ACTION ITEMS:

Section 327-12 D of the Latrobe Code.

Mr. Kelley asked if the utility company that is piercing the road would pave from curb to curb or the whole lane and how will they know what is required of them. Mr. Wajdic explained that it would depend on how much of the road was torn up. Mr. Wajdic also stated that he will be sending out the amended ordinance to all utility companies.

Section 166-42 E of Code of Latrobe.

Amending pole signs to be excluded from the downtown area according to the map.

Section 166-45 F (2) adding (h).

Amending digital message boards which will be restricted to a maximum of twelve square feet on the face of the sign, and that is also on the same map.
