MOTION



Scott found one for \$64,000 and cannot get the price any lower. He is asking for an additional \$4,000 to purchase the truck. The old bucket truck will be sold at approximately \$2,000. The truck will be paid for out of ARPA funds. Mr. Forish made a motion seconded by Mr. Jenko. Approved 5-0.
