- I. **Call to order by Chairman Murray at 7:00 pm.**
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance lead by Dukovic.**
- III. **Present:** John Murray, Art Dukovic, Philip Rovang, Alfredo Gallardo.
  - a. **Also Present:** Board Trustees Patrick Dunham and Patrick Dickson and Jonathan Kellogg
  - b. Quorum present
- IV. **Approval of October 11, 2022 Minutes**  
**Motion by Dukovic, seconded by Rovang. 4 ayes with Kellogg abstaining.**
- V. **Staff Reports: None**
- VI. **Chairman Update Report**
  - a. Memorial Tuck pointing and grouting accomplished last fall. Other repairs to be done this summer.
  - b. Reviewed the updated paver/ brass plaque brochure.
  - c. 2022 Veteran's day event- positive comments about the event.
  - d. Discussed Open meetings law. Need to have everyone complete the class on-line. Encouraged members to complete by next meeting.
  - e. Discussed two veterans who qualify for Commission membership. Will pass it on information to Liaison to forward to Mayor for interview and endorsement.
  - f. Discussed the Budget for the year. Approximately \$1,700. Members agreed to ask Village for Polo Shirts to be worn to Veterans 'events.
  - g. Discussed Fund Raising effort. Discussed various ways to raise funds to pay for repairs.
  - h. Discussed adding three directional signs to help people get to Village Memorial. Two would be passed on Grand Ave. and the other across the street from main entrance off Sand Lake Road. Will need to contact Illinois DOT and lake County Division of Transportation.
  - i. Discussed the need for a street light at entrance to help visitors get to the memorial in evening. Would need to be placed on the CIP for next year.
- VII. New item: Need for new logo for Commission. Dickson proposed a design that would be placed in an oval with the Memorial silhouette in center and the words "Lindenhurst Veterans" on top and "Memorial Commission" near the bottom. Will need to work on details with Administrator.
- VIII. New Item: Chairman discussed the need for information to prepare for the Memorial Day event as soon as possible. May need an additional meeting.

- IX. New item: Discussed the ways we can inform the community and the veterans living the community about the Lindenhurst Veterans Memorial Commission. It is likely that 700 veterans live in Lindenhurst. Should consider having a table at Lindenfest which is scheduled for August 24-27.
