

LINDENHURST BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS 2022 ANNUAL REPORT

2022 was an extremely busy year for your Board. I'm very proud to report that the Board selected and hired five (5) new Police Officers for the department and interviewed nineteen (19) potential candidates for the open positions.

The Board also oversaw the testing (The National Police Officer Selection Test) of sixteen (16) candidates, as administered by the testing firm of Stanard & Associates.

Listed below are the achievements of the Lindenhurst Board of Police Commissioners (LBPC):

- Due to his retirement in late 2021, Chairman Tom Berger, (after 22 years of outstanding service to the Village,) the Board elected William Clark Douglas as its Chairman. Daniel White was elected to Recording Secretary. Mike Collins (retired CPD Police Sergeant), was welcomed by the Board as Commissioner during his first meeting in January 2022.
- A new Entry-Level Police Officer Eligibility List was established in 2022. It will expire in April 2024.
- The Police Officer Lateral Transfer Eligibility list was updated in 2022.
- Commissioner Collins attended training classes conducted by the Illinois Fire and Police Commissioners Association.
- All Commissioners attended training classes conducted by the Illinois Attorney General's Office on the "Open Meetings Act" to ensure compliance of all future meetings.
- The Board interviewed, selected and hired five (5) new Police Officers: James Siefken, Scott Slechter, Ramon Garcia, Shane Siddens and Phil Rathke.
