### **MISSION STATEMENT**

The memorial is a tribute to those members of the Armed Forces who have served the United States in the past, are currently serving, or those that will serve in the future.

### LOCATION

The memorial is located at the North end of the entrance to the Village of Lindenhurst Municipal Center. The site is highly visible to both vehicle and pedestrian traffic along Sand Lake Road. Adequate free municipal parking facilities are also adjacent to the location.

### DESIGN

A committee of residents, now the Lindenhurst Veterans' Memorial Commission, was appointed by the mayor to work on the design of an appropriate memorial to honor all Veterans in a not-for-profit manner. The current memorial is a result of the Commission's past and on-going efforts.

The memorial consists of five free standing black granite monuments each representing a branch of the Armed Services. Spanning the individual monuments is a black granite wall representing the union of all five branches. The memorial represents brotherhood, strength, courage, honor, commitment, patriotism, sacrifice and the price of freedom. At the base of the monument and flowing to either side are three reflecting pools symbolizing our Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, Marines, and Guardsmen's foundations of honor, courage, and sacrifice as well as the tears shed by our nation.

### FUNDRAISING

We are seeking financial support from both individual and corporate sponsors who wish to assist the Commission in their not-for-profit effort to maintain the existing memorial for all times.
