AGENDA TOPICS

Present were Commissioners Ricks, Smith and Weber; Rick Henry, Cameron Stanford and Bart Quayle from the Sheriffs office; Trevin Ricks, Rexburg Fire Dept; and Mike Clements, Homeland Security.

Commissioner Weber began the meeting at 9:35 a.m.

Commissioner Smith explained that he met with Trevin Ricks, Rexburg Fire Dept; Mike Clements, Homeland Security; Lee Sutton, President of the Sunnydale Irrigation District and Gary Wilcox on Monday, April 3, 2017. The group looked at how the high waters of the Snake River are eroding the banks in the Archer/Lyman area and they have asked for the County's help in protecting the river banks. Road and Bridge have 2 dump trucks ready to dispatch to the quarry to help. The county's involvement will be to provide the dump trucks. The irrigation district will provide the rock and people to help place it in the river bank. They believe that a little mitigation up front saves funds later on to include potential county funds. The prediction is that flows will remain high for the next 2 to 3 months.

Commissioner Ricks made a motion to approve and sign Resolution #415 Declaration of a State of Emergency in Madison County. Commissioner Smith seconded and voting was unanimous.

Commissioner Smith made a motion to adjourn at 9:47 p.m. Commissioner Weber seconded and voting was unanimous.
