MADISON SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 321 SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 321, Madison County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of one million nine hundred ninety-five and no/ dollars (\$1,995,000.00) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2024, for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on June 16, 2022?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$83.62 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that expired on June 30, 2022 and that currently costs \$83.62 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change.

The purposes for which the proposed levy revenues will be used and the approximate amount of levy funds to be allocated to each use are as follows:

Safety, Technology, Maintenance and Renovations	\$1,295,000
