TO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SUGAR SALEM MOODY CEMETERY DISTRICT, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO

TO LEVY A PERMANENT OVERRIDE LEVY

Shall the Board of Directors of the Sugar Salem Moody Cemetery District be authorized to levy a permanent override in the amount of 95,000.00 per year on a permanent basis commencing tax year beginning 2024, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses as provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors of the Sugar Salem Moody Cemetery District adopted on February 21, 2024?

The maximum annual cost to a taxpayer in the Sugar Salem Moody Cemetery District is \$40.00 per \$100,000.00 of assessed property value. This override would result in an estimated increase to \$26.46 per \$100,000.00 annually of assessed property value based on current conditions.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$101.40 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase by \$101.40.
