4. Matters discussed at Open Forum will typically be referred to Administration with a request for a follow-up report.
5. Any matters involving personnel or insurance claims will be immediately referred to the City Administrator or City Attorney.
6. The City Council will not typically take action but may ask questions to clarify a question or comment.
7. Robert's Rules of Order will govern the meeting.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of North Mankato will hold its regular meeting on June 7, 2021, at 7:00 pm at 1001 Belgrade Avenue.

In accordance with the requirements of Minn. Stat. Section 13D.021, the City Administrator, has determined that an in-person meeting is not practical or prudent because of a health pandemic or an emergency declared under Chapter 12 of the Minnesota Statutes.

Because of the health pandemic, it has been determined that attendance at the regular meeting location by members of the public is not feasible.
