Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a regular meeting of the North Mankato City Council was held in the Municipal Building Council Chambers on April 2, 2018. Mayor Dehen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. asking that everyone join in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following were present for roll call: Mayor Dehen, Council Members Norland, Freyberg, and Steiner, City Administrator Harrenstein, Finance Director McCann, Attorney Kennedy, Community Development Director Fischer, and City Clerk Van Genderen. Absent: Council Member Whitlock.

Approval of Agenda

Council Member Norland moved, seconded by Council Member Steiner, to approve the agenda as presented. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Approval of Council and Open Forum Meeting Minutes

Council Member Norland moved, seconded by Council Member Steiner, to approve the minutes of the Council and Open Forum meeting of March 19, 2018. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Public Hearing, 7 p.m. Revision of Code of Ordinances.

Community Development Director Fischer reviewed the proposed Code of Ordinance changes. The information was available for review before the meeting and included changes to City Code 91.04 Farm Animals, 156.052 Nonconforming Uses, 156.035 Generally, 151.11 Conduct on Licensed Premises, 52.07 Water Meters, and 156.054 Performance Standards.

Barb Church, 102 Wheeler Avenue, appeared before Council and requested clarification on 151.11 Conduct on Licensed Premises. Attorney Kennedy clarified that the responsible party is the licensee, not the tenant. Ms. Church indicated the language was confusing. Ms. Church also spoke about City Code 156.054 concerning fences being required to follow the unaltered natural terrain of the property. Mayor Dehen asked if a variance could be used to accommodate Ms. Church's request. Community Development Director Fischer reported that would be a possibility. Community Development Director reported the Code does require the fence to follow the terrain.

Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Council Member Steiner moved, seconded by Council Member Norland to Adopt Ordinance No. 102 Fourth Series, An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances for the City of North Mankato, Minnesota Revising, Updating and Compiling Certain Ordinances of the City Dealing with the Subjects Embraced in the Code of Ordinances and Providing Penalties for the Violation of the Code of Ordinances. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Res. No. 35-18 Declaring Cost to be Assessed and Ordering Preparation of Proposed Assessment Project No. 17-05 ABCDEF, Jefferson Avenue Reconstruction Project.

City Engineer Sarff appeared before Council and stated he would discuss Items #10B and #10C together. He indicated the first resolution declares the costs to be assessed and orders the preparation of the assessment roll. City Engineer Sarff stated the City received six bids for the project with WW Blacktopping as the low bid at \$360,095.75 which was 7% below the Engineer's Estimate. He recommended awarding WW Blacktopping the contract. City Engineer Sarff reported Item #10C sets the Public Hearing for the proposed assessment for Project No. 17-05 ABCDEF, Jefferson Avenue Reconstruction Project. He indicated the proposed assessment per property was capped at \$6,000, and the calculated cost for the improvement was greater than the \$6,000. The total amount proposed to be assessed was \$114,000 for the 19 properties. City Engineer Sarff indicated there was a significant reduction in cost to the property owner due to the assessment cap. Council Member Norland moved, seconded by Council Member Steiner to Adopt Res. No. 35-18 Declaring Cost to be Assessed and Ordering Preparation of Proposed Assessment Project No. 17-05 ABCDEF, Jefferson Avenue Reconstruction Project. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Res. No. 36-18 for Hearing on Proposed Assessment Project No. 17-05 ABCDEF, Jefferson Avenue Reconstruction Project. Council Member Steiner moved, seconded by Council Member Norland to Adopt Res. No. 36-18 for Hearing on Proposed Assessment Project No. 17-05 ABCDEF, Jefferson Avenue Reconstruction Project. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Res. No. 38-18 Approving Plans and Specifications and Ordering Advertisement for Bids Project No. 18-03DE, 2018 Street Improvement Project.

City Engineer Sarff reported with the adoption of the Pavement Management Study the City continues to prioritize mill and overlay projects. There are a total of 8 projects being contemplated for 2018 including Raymond Drive Bituminous Wearing Course, Spring Lake Park Hockey Rink and Parking Lot/Driveway, Roe Crest Drive from Commerce Drive to Lee Boulevard, Tower Boulevard from Commerce Drive to Lee Boulevard, Howard Drive from Lor Ray Drive to Countryside Drive, Sherwood Drive from Nottingham Drive to dead-end cul-de-sac, Lor Ray Drive from Lee Boulevard to Clare Drive, and Haughton Avenue from Howard Drive to Countryside Drive. City Engineer Sarff reported the budget was \$380,000 and the City would have a base bid along with alternate bids. He did not anticipate the City being able to complete all of the projects. City Engineer Sarff stated bids would be opened on May 7, 2018. Mayor Dehen requested clarification on the inclusion of Raymond Drive considering lots would be added. City Administrator Harrenstein reported there were concerns

about Raymond Drive because it has gone so long with just the base, the work would be to construct the final layer of the road. He also reported there was an attempt to balance the work between residential and industrial to ensure the Pavement Management System was working for everyone. Mayor Dehen stated it might be a good idea to reevaluate the Pavement Management Study when a new Public Works Director was hired. Council Member Freyberg moved, seconded by Council Member Norland to Adopt Res. No. 38-18 Approving Plans and Specifications and Ordering Advertisement for Bids Project No. 18-03DE, 2018 Street Improvement Project. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Res. No. 37-18 Ordering Preparation of Report on Improvement, North Port Industrial Park West.

City Engineer Sarff stated a drawing was included in the packet showing the North Port Industrial Park. The City recently received a grant through the Greater Minnesota Business Development Public Infrastructure Grant Program (BDPI) for the extension of sanitary sewer and watermain to provide service to the area. City Engineer Sarff reported things were developing in the industrial park and challenges were developing. A sanitary sewer lift station will be required for further development in the area. City staff has recently negotiated terms of an agreement with MnDOT sharing the existing stormwater ponds in MnDOT owned property adjacent to Highway 14 which can be utilized as a regional stormwater pond for the area. In order to verify the street and utility layouts and to determine an estimated cost, it is recommended that a preliminary engineering report is authorized. City Engineer Sarff encouraged the City to apply for additional BDPI grants for the infrastructure improvements. Council Member Norland moved, seconded by Council Member Steiner to adopt Res. No. 37-18 Ordering Preparation of Report on Improvement, North Port Industrial Park West. Vote on the motion: Norland, Freyberg, Steiner and Dehen aye; no nays. Motion carried.

Review 2019 Budget & Proposed 2019-2028 CIP Schedule.

Finance Director McCann continued the 2019-2028 CIP Schedule review by discussing three streets in lower North Mankato that merit consideration for reconstruction. The streets included Tyler Avenue from Cross Street to Range Street, Harrison Avenue from Cross Street to Range Street and McKinley Avenue from Sherman Street to Range Street. The projects include replacing or adding utilities, street, curb, gutter, sidewalks and driveway aprons. Tyler and Harrison's projects are estimated at \$370,800 each and McKinley Avenue is estimated at \$1,123,200. City Administrator Harrenstein reported this would be a good opportunity to chip away at projects and approach them in smaller pieces. Mayor Dehen stated Tyler and Harrison have issues and it would be good to complete some of the long-standing projects.

Open Forum

<u>Kim Spears, 916 South Avenue</u>, appeared before Council and read a portion of an interview he conducted with an MSU student concerning public comments.

<u>Barb Church, 102 Wheeler Avenue</u>, appeared before Council and discussed the City of North Mankato contributing to help raise the Highway 169/Highway 14 Levee.

<u>Lucy Lowry, 2263 Northridge Drive</u>, appeared before Council and discussed cooperation with Mankato, specifically concerning the Highway 169/Highway 14 Levee project.

Tom Hagen, 927 Lake Street, appeared before Council and spoke about public comments and requested the use of the City trail cam for use on his property.

Phil Henry, 1300 Noretta Drive, appeared before Council spoke about public comments and stated the staff should not be able to comment during a public comment period.

Mayor Dehen commented the City of North Mankato has not precluded contributing to the Highway 169/Highway 14 Levee project. He indicated the City is waiting for bids and to see if additional funds can be received from the State or the Federal government and will continue the conversation with Mankato.

City Administrator and Staff Comments

Attorney Kennedy noted some individuals expect an immediate response when speaking during the Open Forum. Going forward the Council will need to continue to work through the Open Forum process.

Mayor and Council Comments

Council Member Norland thanked Library Director Katie Heintz for the Community Read book "The Family Romanov."

Council Member Steiner sent best wishes to Council Member Whitlock who just finished his cancer treatments. He also indicated agreement with Mayor Dehen that the City does not plan on backing out on the City of Mankato and is waiting for more information.

Mayor Dehen wished Council Member Whitlock the best and indicated he enjoyed the Community Read book.

There being no further business, on a motion by Council Member Norland, seconded by Council Member Steiner, the meeting adjourned at 7:48 p.m.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA ANNEXING LAND LOCATED IN BELGRADE TOWNSHIP, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES § 414.033 SUBDIVISION 2(3), PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, a petition signed by all the property owners, requesting that property legally described in Exhibit A be annexed to the City of North Mankato Minnesota, was duly presented to the Council of the City of North Mankato on the 5th day of March 2018; and

WHEREAS, said property is unincorporated and abuts the City of North Mankato on its West boundary; is less than 120 acres; is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available; and

WHEREAS, said property is not located within a flood plain or shoreland area; and

WHEREAS, said property is currently farmland and ravine property and annexation is requested to facilitate the extension of city services for the industrial development of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Mankato held a public hearing pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.033 Subd. 2b, on April 16, 2018, following thirty (30) days written notice by certified mail to the Township of Belgrade and to all landowners within and contiguous to the area legally described in Exhibit A, to be annexed; and

NOTE: Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.033, Subd. 11, when a municipality declares land annexed to the municipality under subdivision 2, clause (3), and the land is within a designated floodplain, as provided by section 103F.111, subdivision 4, or a shoreland area, as provided by section 103F.205, subdivision 4, the municipality shall adopt or amend its land use controls to conform to chapter 103F, and any new development of the annexed land shall be subject to chapter 103F.

NOTE: Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.033, Subd. 12, when a municipality annexes land under subdivision 2, clause (2), (3) or (4), property taxes payable on the annexed land shall continue to be paid to the affected town or towns for the year in which the annexation becomes effective. If the annexation becomes effective on or before August 1 of a levy year, the municipality may levy on the annexed area beginning with that same levy year. If the annexation becomes effective after August 1 of a levy year, the town may continue to levy on the annexed area for that levy year, and the municipality may not levy on the annexed area until the following levy year.

NOTE: Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.033, Subd 13, at least 30 days before a municipality may adopt an ordinance under subdivision 2, clause (2), (3), or (4), the petitioner must be notified by the municipality that the cost of electric utility service to the petitioner may change if the land is annexed to the municipality. The notice must include an estimate of the cost impact of any change in electric utility services, including rate changes and assessments, resulting from the annexation.



ANNEXATION REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO AND BELGRADE TOWNSHIP

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. Sec. 414.036:

Unless otherwise agreed to by the annexing municipality and the affected town, when an order or other approval under this chapter annexes part of a town to a municipality the order or other approval must provide a reimbursement from the municipality to the town for all or part of the taxable property annexed as part of the order. The reimbursement shall be completed in substantially equal payments over not less than two nor more than eight years from the time of annexation. The municipality must reimburse the township for all special assessments assigned by the townships to the annexed property and any portion of debt incurred by the town prior to the annexation and attributable to the property to be annexed but for which no special assessments are outstanding, in substantially equal payments over a period of not less than two or no more than eight years.

In accordance with this State Statute, the City of North Mankato will reimburse Belgrade Township an annual amount based on the property taxes collected by Belgrade Township in the last year it collected taxes on any land valued over \$50,000 which the City of North Mankato annexes into its City limits. There will be no reimbursement for land valued under \$50,000 which the City annexes. Any reimbursement shall be paid for a period of five years. The City reserves the right to pre-pay at any time.

Audio Permit

About:

An audio permit is required for anyone operating outdoor amplified sound (i.e., a loudspeaker, public address system, or sound amplifying equipment). All Audio Permits must be approved by the Council. The sound system cannot be operated before 7:00 am or after 10:00 pm. There is a \$25 fee.

Audio Permit Responsibilities:

- An onsite event coordinator must be available by mobile during the event.
- An applicant will provide a schedule of any music or entertainment proposed to occur during the event.
- A beginning and end time must be supplied on the application, and the event coordinator must ensure compliance.
- Applicants must comply with City Code Ordinance 90.045 and Minnesota Rules Chapter 7030 which limits noise.
- Noise levels cannot exceed 60 dBA more than 50 percent of the time.

What happens if there is a noise complaint?

- A North Mankato Patrol Officer will meet with the complainant and evaluate and measure the noise
 using a decibel reader at the location of the complainant.
- If the noise is found out of compliance, the Patrol Officer will contact the onsite event coordinator, and the amplified sound must be turned down.
- If the onsite event coordinator does not comply, the event will be immediately terminated, and the group will be disbursed.
- Failure to comply will affect future ability to obtain an audio permit.





An audio permit is required for anyone operating outdoor amplified sound (i.e., a loudspeaker, public address system, or sound amplifying equipment). All Audio Permits must be approved by the Council. The sound system cannot be operated before 7:00 am or after 10:00 pm. There is a \$25 fee.

Audio Permit Responsibilities:

- An onsite event coordinator must be available by mobile during the event.
- An applicant will provide a schedule of any music or entertainment proposed to occur during the event.
- A beginning and end time must be supplied on the application, and the event coordinator must ensure compliance.
- Applicants must comply with City Code Ordinance 90.045 and Minnesota Rules Chapter 7030 which limits noise.
- Noise levels cannot exceed 60 dBA more than 50 percent of the time.

What happens if there is a noise complaint?

- A North Mankato Patrol Officer will meet with the complainant and evaluate and measure the noise
 using a decibel reader at the location of the complainant.
- If the noise is found out of compliance, the Patrol Officer will contact the onsite event coordinator, and the amplified sound must be turned down.
- If the onsite event coordinator does not comply, the event will be immediately terminated, and the group will be disbursed.
- Failure to comply will affect future ability to obtain an audio permit.

ORDINANCE NO. 103, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA ANNEXING LAND LOCATED IN BELGRADE TOWNSHIP, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES § 414.033 SUBDIVISION 2(3), PERMITTING ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, a petition signed by all the property owners, requesting that property legally described in Exhibit A be annexed to the City of North Mankato Minnesota, was duly presented to the Council of the City of North Mankato on the 5th day of March 2018; and

WHEREAS, said property is unincorporated and abuts the City of North Mankato on its West boundary; is less than 120 acres; is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available; and

WHEREAS, said property is not located within a flood plain or shoreland area; and

WHEREAS, said property is currently farmland and ravine property and annexation is requested to facilitate the extension of city services for the industrial development of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Mankato held a public hearing pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.033 Subd. 2b, on April 16, 2018, following thirty (30) days written notice by certified mail to the Township of Belgrade and to all landowners within and contiguous to the area legally described in Exhibit A, to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, provisions of Minnesota Statutes § 414.033 Subd. 13 are not applicable in that there will be no change in the electric utility service provider resulting from the annexation of the territory to the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby determines that the property as hereinafter described abuts the city limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in nature in that industrial use is being proposed for said property the construction of which requires or will need city services, including public sewer facilities.
- 2. None of the property is now included within the limits of any city, or in any area that has already been designated for orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 414.0325.
- 3. The corporate limits of the City of North Mankato, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the following described property, said land abutting the City of North Mankato and being 120 acres or less in area, and is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available, and the City having received a petition for annexation from all the property owners of the land, to wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 108 North Range 27 West, Nicollet County, Minnesota, described as:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 2, Block 5, Burnett's Ravine Ridge No. 3, according to the plat thereof on file and of record with the Nicollet County Recorder; thence South 00 degrees

34 minutes 33 seconds East, (Minnesota County Coordinate System - Nicollet County Zone - HARN NAD83 - 1996), along the westerly right of way line of Raymond Drive, according to said Burnett's Ravine Ridge No. 3, a distance of 797.66 feet to the point of intersection with the southerly line of Aspen Lane, according to said Burnett's Ravine Ridge No. 3; thence South 89 degrees 25 minutes 27 seconds West, along the westerly extension of the southerly line of said Aspen Lane, a distance of 130.00 feet to the point of intersection with the southerly extension of the west line of said Lot 2, thence North 00 degrees 34 minutes 33 seconds West, along said extension, a distance of 797.66 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 2; thence North 89 degrees 25 minutes 27 seconds East, along the south line of said Lot 2, a distance of 130.00 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 2.38 acres.

- 4. That the population of the area legally described herein and hereby annexed is 0.

The City of North Mankato pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.036, and in accordance with the reimbursement agreement (Exhibit C) that with respect to the property taxes payable on the area legally described herein, herby annexed, shall make a cash payment to Belgrade Township of \$165.25 and shall not receive any further property tax income from the land commencing with the tax year 2017.
- 6. That pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.036 with respect to any special assessments assigned by the Town to the annexed property and any portion of debt incurred by the Town prior to the annexation and attributable to the property to be annexed, but for which no special assessments are outstanding, for the area legally described there are no special assessments or debt incurred by the Town on the subject are for which reimbursement is required.







ANNEXATION REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO AND BELGRADE TOWNSHIP

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. Sec. 414.036:

Unless otherwise agreed to by the annexing municipality and the affected town, when an order or other approval under this chapter annexes part of a town to a municipality the order or other approval must provide a reimbursement from the municipality to the town for all or part of the taxable property annexed as part of the order. The reimbursement shall be completed in substantially equal payments over not less than two nor more than eight years from the time of annexation. The municipality must reimburse the township for all special assessments assigned by the townships to the annexed property and any portion of debt incurred by the town prior to the annexation and attributable to the property to be annexed but for which no special assessments are outstanding, in substantially equal payments over a period of not less than two or no more than eight years.

In accordance with this State Statute, the City of North Mankato will reimburse Belgrade Township an annual amount based on the property taxes collected by Belgrade Township in the last year it collected taxes on any land valued over \$50,000 which the City of North Mankato annexes into its City limits. There will be no reimbursement for land valued under \$50,000 which the City annexes. Any reimbursement shall be paid for a period of five years. The City reserves the right to pre-pay at any time.

WHEREAS, Caswell Sports continues to grow in funding with revenue from events, lodging tax, sponsorships and donation; and

WHEREAS, Caswell Sports seeks to continue to possibly expand in the future with indoor recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, Caswell Sports operations are significant enough to warrant the establishment of a separate fund to track the expenditures and revenues associated with all the current and future Caswell Sports operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1. The City of North Mankato establishes Fund 201 Caswell Regional Sporting Complex Fund to better track all Caswell Sports operations, including all activities and events associated with softball, soccer, future indoor recreation, and other sporting, cultural, recreational activities and events as determined by staff.
- 2. All expenditures associated with Caswell Sports Caswell Softball, Caswell North Soccer, community events, and other such programs that bring a wide range of visitors to the community will be recorded in this fund.
- 3. All revenues associated with Caswell Sports Caswell Softball, Caswell North Soccer, community events, and other such programs that bring a wide range of visitors to the community will be allocated to this fund, including lodging tax revenues and any other future revenues designated to the complex.
- 4. Any revenue shortfalls will be made up with an operating transfer from the General Fund at the end of the year.
- 5. The fund will be overseen by the Caswell Sports Director, Finance Director, and City Administrator.

Re: 2019-2028 CIP Planning Discussion

Overview

This memo is a continuation of the ongoing 2019-2028 CIP Planning Process. We will continue to discuss currently identified CIP projects so the council can give direction for the 2019-2028 CIP. The goal is to have additional discussion regarding projects identified on the CIP, but may have received little discussion in the past. As we discuss projects, the focus will be on projects that have been identified for construction, but funding has not been identified.

Presidents' Row Street Reconstructs

Building off of the Jefferson Ave. reconstruction project slated for this summer and the discussion from the last council meeting regarding Tyler, Harrison, and McKinley Avenues street and utility reconstruction projects, there are additional streets in the community meriting consideration for reconstruction. In 2013, a street assessment was done by North Mankato Public Works staff and Bolton and Menk to identify the streets needing to be updated. Roe Crest Ave. and Jefferson Ave. were identified as the top projects to complete, along with the aforementioned streets. There are other top identified projects for consideration to complete next consisting of:

- MONROE AVENUE STREET & UTILITY PROJECT
- GRANT AVENUE STREET & UTILITY PROJECT
- GARFIELD AVENUE STREET & UTILITY PROJECT



Scope of Work

These projects involve replacing or adding utilities (where applicable), street, curb, gutter, sidewalks (where applicable), and driveway aprons.

Current Project Estimates

- Monroe Avenue \$ 756,000
- Grant Avenue \$ 381,900
- Garfield Avenue\$ 696,000

Consideration

The Grant Avenue street project is smaller in scope, similar to the Jefferson Avenue project, which could be completed in conjunction with a larger bond issuance for several small projects, or if bond proceeds remain from a previous project, reallocated to these projects. The Monroe and Garfield Projects are larger in scope, due to the length of these blocks. These three projects also involve churches and schools, which legally can still be assessed. As the City works toward reconstructing the projects, we should set target year several years out so that these entities have several years' notice of the project and estimated assessments.

Since these project do not currently have any funding sources identified, the project is currently at the end of the 2018-2027 CIP. With the goal to continue to reconstruct the Presidents' row streets, staff recommends completion of either Tyler or Harrison in 2019 and including at least on block of these reconstruction projects in the city's annual bond issue. Staff recommends these projects to remain on the CIP, but be listed as unfunded until additional funding sources can be identified.
