About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™, the City of North Mankato conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in February and data were collected through April 5th, 2017. About five weeks into data collection, the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from March 22nd to April 5th and 174 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and data have not been weighted to current population estimates of North Mankato.
