Learn to Swim Level 1 (6yr - 8yr) Introduction to Water Skills

Help participants develop positive attitudes and safe practices around water.

 Skills worked on will include entering and exiting the water safely, breath control, floating, glides, combined arm and leg actions, and recovering to standing

Learn to Swim Level 2 (7yr-9yr) Fundamentals of Aquatics

Building upon aquatic skills, water safety skills and concepts from level one.

- Works on entering and exiting shoulder deep water, submerging and holding breath safely, floating progressions, treading arm and leg actions, and changing directions while swimming
- If you're planning to register a child for this class, please be aware that the participants are expected to move in the water unassisted

Learn to Swim Level 3 (8yr-10yr) Stroke Development

Build on concepts from levels one and two.

- Will work on entering water by jumping in deep water and recovering unassisted, treading water for one-minute, headfirst entries, and streamline to swim
- To pass participants will swim 15 yards by using front crawl, elementary backstroke, scissor kick, and breaststroke arms

Learn to Swim Level 4 (10+yrs) Stroke Improvement

Designed for improvement of participants proficiency in performing the swimming strokes from Level 3.

- Skills worked on include swimming underwater three to five body lengths, tread water for two minutes, and work on turns for front and back crawl
- To pass, participants will swim 25 yards in front crawl and elementary backstroke and 15 yards in butterfly, breaststroke, back crawl, and sidestroke

Learn to Swim Level 5 (10+yrs) Stroke Refinement

Refine participants proficiency in performing all six swimming strokes (front crawl, back crawl, butterfly, breaststroke, elementary backstroke, and sidestroke) and build endurance.

 Other skills worked on are treading water for four minutes and learn flip or open turns for all strokes
