

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE GREENWAY CONSERVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, chapter eight of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan of North Mankato calls for the creation of a “greenway system that provides recreational opportunities, protects and enhances natural resources, is valued by the community, and can be maintained long-term by the city; and

WHEREAS, chapter seven of the North Mankato Master Parks Plan identifies future consideration of the urban forest and greenway system; and

WHEREAS, prairie restoration and invasive species eradication present on-going operational priorities of the North Mankato Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, the North Mankato Parks Department has benefited from collaboration with citizens and other agencies to promote the conservation and maintenance of the city’s greenways; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA,

1. *Creation & Name:* A Greenway Conservation Advisory Committee is hereby established.
2. *Membership:* The Greenway Conservation Advisory Committee shall be comprised of three members that include a member of the City Council, a person with verifiable professional expertise and years of experience in conservation, and a citizen. The City Council member shall serve as the chairperson of the advisory committee.
3. *Term:* For the initial terms of the commission, one member shall be appointed for one year, one member shall be appointed for two years, and another member shall be appointed for three years. All subsequent terms shall be for three years.
4. *Purpose:* The Greenway Conservation Advisory Committee is an advisory body to the City Administrator, Public Works Director, Parks Department and citizens regarding the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan and the Parks Master Plan as they relate specifically to the maintenance, enhancement, and enjoyment of the natural features and trails within the boundaries of North Mankato for citizens.


5. *Initial Appointment and Terms:*

City Council – Robert Freyberg, 3 year term, beginning January 1, 2016

Conservation Professional – Randy Schindle, 2 year term, beginning January 1, 2016


Citizen – Scott Seigfreid, 1 year term, beginning January 1, 2016
