**SPRING LAKE PARK**  
**641 Webster Ave, North Mankato, MN 56003**

At 52 acres, SPRING LAKE PARK, with its swim facility, playgrounds, sand volleyball courts, ball fields and winter activities of skating (hockey) and sledding, has something for everyone. There are five picnic shelters in the park. The lighted, paved walking trail around the lake is approximately 0.675 mile (1 loop). The picnic shelters at Spring Lake Park are an ideal place to hold your family reunion, company picnic or graduation.

**Shelters #1 and #2 in the northwest corner of the park and Shelter #5 in the southwest corner may be reserved.** Check availability online or by contacting City Hall at 625-4141. The cost is \$100 per shelter per day. If you plan to have a keg at your event, there is a \$300 damage deposit and \$30 keg permit fee required. If you plan to use a microphone and speakers at your event, an Audio Permit is required with a \$25 fee. Park hours are from 4 A.M. to 10 P.M.

The sand volleyball courts are adjacent to shelters #1 & 2. They are located at the corner of Webster Avenue and Lake Street. There is a playground situated between these shelters. Shelter #5 is located at the corner of Lake Street and Lakeview Avenue. There is a playground adjacent to shelter #5.

**The two remaining shelters (3 & 4) located on the east side of the park are on a first-come, first-served basis.**

- 12-15 Picnic Tables
- Basketball court

Shelters are handicap accessible. Trash cans with bags are supplied at each shelter. Large groups may wish to bring in extra bags which can be tied up and left by the cans.

**One week before the event:** If any tents are to be used or staking of any type is to be done you must contact **Gopher State One Call** at 800-252-1166. They need to locate the underground water and power lines, so they are not damaged.

**PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following rules and regulations have been set by the City Code which applies to all parks and is enforced:

**PROHIBITED:**

- \*Vehicles are not allowed to be parked or driven on the grass for any reason without permission from the Park Dept.
- \*Glass containers.
- \*Campfires / Bonfires / Fire rings.
- \*Snowmobiles / ATVs.
- \*Audio equipment may not be played so loud as to interfere with the reasonable use of the park by others. All audio devices shall end at 10 p.m. *An Audio Permit must be completed, and approved by Council, for amplified sound.*

**ALLOWED:**

- \*Personal grills may be brought in.
- \*Pets (Allowed in Benson Park, Spring Lake Park and Bluff Park only).
- \*Keg beer is allowed only with a permit.
- \*Hog roasts are allowed in the parks on hard-surfaced lots only.
