WHEELER PARK

402 Page Ave (Corner of Page and Center), North Mankato, MN 56003

At 12½ acres, WHEELER PARK is the City’s oldest park. The lower area in the park was dug out for brick making by a local business in the early part of the century. This park is the site of the annual North Mankato Fun Days celebration in July. There are two picnic shelters. One is enclosed and can be reserved; the other is open and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Tennis courts, basketball courts, 12 clay horseshoe courts, and two playground areas, along with a large skating rink for winter use make Wheeler Park an ideal place to hold your family reunion, company picnic or graduation.

The enclosed shelter at Wheeler Park may be reserved. Check availability online or by contacting City Hall at 625-4141. The cost is \$100 per day. If you plan to have a keg at your event, there is a \$300 damage deposit and \$30 keg permit fee required. If you plan to use a microphone and speakers at your event, an Audio Permit is required with a \$25 fee. Park hours are from 4 A.M. to 10 P.M.

The enclosed shelter is a locked facility and requires a key. You must plan to pick up a key from City Hall before your event. You must return the key within 3 days of your event.

The open shelter is available on a first-come, first-served basis. This shelter has electricity.

The restrooms are connected to the enclosed shelter. Trash cans with bags are supplied at each shelter. Large groups may wish to bring in extra bags which can be tied up and left by the cans.

One week before the event: If any tents are to be used or staking of any type is to be done you must contact **Gopher State One Call** at 800-252-1166. They need to locate the underground water and power lines, so they are not damaged.

PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been set by the City Code which applies to all parks and is enforced:

PROHIBITED:

- *Vehicles are not allowed to be parked or driven on the grass for any reason without permission from the Park Dept.
- *Pets (Allowed in Benson Park, Spring Lake Park and Bluff Park only).
- *Glass containers.
- *Campfires / Bonfires / Fire rings.
- *Snowmobiles / ATVs.
- *Audio equipment may not be played so loud as to interfere with the reasonable use of the park by others.
 All audio devices shall end at 10 p.m. *An Audio Permit must be completed for all amplified sound.*

ALLOWED:

- *Personal grills may be brought in.
- *Keg beer is allowed only with a permit.
- *Hog roasts are allowed in the parks on hard-surfaced lots only.
