PETITION TO REMOVE ADMINISTRATRIX

I, KELLIE LYNN GREEN, daughter of the deceased, Gary Russell Rush, Sr., hereby petition for the removal of Anita Marlene Rush as Administratrix of the Estate of Gary Russell Rush, Sr.

Anita Marlene Rush was appointed as Administratrix on July 9, 2019, and bond was set at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

The Administratrix has violated her oath as fiduciary of the estate in that:

(1) She filed an Appraisement of the estate that did not list all of the assets the decedent owned at the time of his death.

(2) She allowed her interest in the real estate in which the petitioner has a future interest to fall into disrepair and has otherwise committed waste on the property.

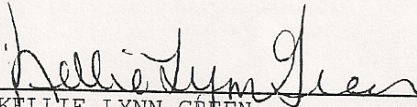
(3) She has distributed estate property to nonheirs.

ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING
DELINQUENT OR UNPROGRESSED ESTATES

1. Pursuant to the provisions of West Virginia Code § 44-3A-24, the County Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against the personal representatives of the attached Estates on the 1st day of July, 2020, requiring the respective appointed personal representatives to file a statement within thirty (30) days after the mailing of the Order to Show Cause, why the County Commission should not find the personal representative delinquent in his or her administration of the respective estate, and why the County Commission should not remove the personal representative from office, administratively close the estate, or take other action against the personal representative as may be proper as allowed by the laws of the State of West Virginia.
2. On July 15, 2020, the Fiduciary Supervisor mailed the Show Cause Order to the appointed personal representatives and to the other interested parties, and more than thirty (30) days after the mailing of the Orders have elapsed.
3. The personal representatives are still delinquent in his or her administrations of their respective estates, or the Fiduciary Supervisor has received no verified statement of the personal representatives.
4. A Notice of the hearing before the County Commission to be held on October 21, 2020, was published on October 2, 2019, in the Fairmont Times, a newspaper of general circulation in this County, in accordance with the provisions of law.
5. A hearing before the County Commission in this matter was held on October 21, 2020, at 10:30 am, at the County Commission chambers.
6. At the hearing, no good cause was shown by any person or otherwise known to the County Commission as to why the following estates should not be administratively closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon consideration of all of the above, the County Commission FINDS that, pursuant to the provision of West Virginia Code §44-3A-24, the following estates are delinquent or have not been duly closed within a period of three years from the opening of such estates and in which no progress has been made toward the settlement of such estates, and the County Commission does hereby ORDER that the estates are ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED, all in accordance with the laws of the State of West Virginia. Any bond of the below named personal representatives, and the sureties or obligors thereon, shall remain and be open and liable for action in accordance with law including the provisions of West Virginia Code §44-1-26.

Public Comment

Robin Smith and Becky Williams of Mannington BAD (Bark Against Drugs) provided the Commission with additional information regarding their efforts to secure a Service Dog to aid in situations of drug detection, tracking, and missing persons, etc. for the City of Mannington. They reported that they are half way in meeting their goal of \$20,000 and ask the Commission for their support in helping to meet their goal. They further explained that the North Marion citizens feel a need for a Service Dog for their area, but are open to sharing their canine unit to help meet other needs within the county.
