

**TOWN OF MARLBOROUGH
PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET 2023/2024
MONDAY MAY 1, 2023

Mike Nastri, Chair of the Board of Finance called the Town Meeting to order at 7:25 p.m. He asked Lauren Griffin, Town Clerk, to read the Legal Notice into the record. Lauren Griffin asked for a motion to nominate a moderator. **Joe Asklar made a motion to nominate Mike Nastri. Ken Hjulstrom seconded the nomination for Mike Nastri.** The Town Clerk asked if there were any other nominations. There were none. Lauren Griffin asked for those in favor of Mike Nastri to say “aye”. Then she called for those not in favor to say “nay”. There were no “nays”. **Lauren Griffin named Mike Nastri as moderator.** Mike Nastri then turned the meeting over to Deb Bourbeau, Chair of the Selectmen, to explain the 2023-2024 Budget.

Deb Bourbeau gave a brief explanation about the work that went into preparing the budget, and outlined the three questions that were to be voted on the following day. The proposed budget would decrease Marlborough’s mill rate by .82 mills. When she completed her presentation, she asked if any members of the public would like to speak. There were no comments. She then announced that the budget would move to referendum May 2, 2023 in the Elmer Thienes Community Room from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Deb Bourbeau concluded the Public Hearing at 7:39 pm.
