Peter Hughes discussed the current budget and grinder pumps status.

Peter reported on the budget; YTD spending is \$238K, leaving \$166K for the rest of the year. However, there are adjustments outstanding from pump repairs (\$20K) and cross-charges (\$44K) that will reduce the remaining balance. Peter thought the remaining balance should be adequate as there are spare pumps in stock.

There were additional discussions related to long-term planning in the budget for expected pump failures as they have a life expectancy of 15 years. In addition, with the anticipated new apartments and condominium developments the demand will increase and there will be a corresponding increase in revenue which should be saved for future repairs. The systems are expected to manage the added volume.

Peter noted that the pump house was cleaned about a month ago and is scheduled for cleaning again in May.

There was also a question regarding the sewer users list and is it part of the GIS system. Peter noted the list needs updating and the possibility of adding a mapping layer to GIS.
