## Village of Maywood Mayor Selected as NLC Youth Excel Fellow

Commits to Enhancing Maywood-West Cook Career & Life Readiness Initiative Through Expanding Collaboration and Partnership to Build on Resources and Opportunities for Youth

Maywood-IL, Village President, Nathaniel George Booker has been named a Youth Excel Fellow as a part of the National League of Cities' (NLC) Youth Excel Initiative. Through the Youth Excel Initiative, Fellows work in close partnership with NLC to help their cities promote long-term community economic security by developing partnerships and implementing strategies that improve access to high-quality postsecondary education and career pathway opportunities that lead to high-wage jobs. The initiative has a specific focus on supporting BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, or People of Color) youth and Opportunity Youth, or those who have become disconnected from school and the workforce. With a firm commitment to incorporating the voices of both youth and employers, the Initiative seeks to ensure that the Fellows' work leads to impactful opportunities for young people in STEM along with all careers that provide Elements of a Healthy Maywood-West Cook.

Mayor Booker joins 12 other municipal leaders from cities across the nation to engage in monthly peer-to-peer virtual learning opportunities and receive tailored technical assistance from NLC's staff and national content experts as they work to advance the communities efforts in developing high-quality career pathways for young people.

"I am excited to enhance the work we have started here in the Village of Eternal Light and West Suburban Cook County (West Cook) in partnership with NLC," said Mayor Nathaniel George Booker. "Maywood-West Cook Career & Life Readiness Initiative has already made a positive impact since we launched in January 2023 with more than 300 middle & high school students registered in enrichment programming. This program and more collaborative partners will aide in taking us to the next level."

The Youth Excel Initiative, operated out of the National League of Cities' Center for Leadership, Advancement, Education, and Development, addresses the urgent need to develop community-wide approaches to workforce development that prepare youth to access high-quality careers. This initiative provides expert assistance to support cities and partners as they improve outcomes for youth and young people who are marginalized from economic success. This cohort program runs from April 2023 through December 2023 and is made possible through the generous support of the Siemens Foundation.












The general contractor and subcontractors will be working on sawcuts, concrete restorations and manhole adjustments along Wilcox Street from 19th Ave. to 21st Ave., 8th Avenue from Green St. to School St., 3rd Ave. from Madison St. to School St., 2nd Ave. from Madison St. to School St., School St. from 1st Ave. to 3rd Ave., and Erie St. from 1st Ave. to 3rd Ave.

The contractor has also started the concrete pavement restoration on St. Charles Road.

#### 2022 Green Infrastructure Alley Improvements

The contractor will be completing punch list work over the next several weeks.

#### **Washington Boulevard Improvements**

- Lindahl continued pavement removal and grading from 21st Avenue to 19th Avenue.
- Lindahl continued concrete removals and excavation for concrete replacements from 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Concrete Curb and gutter from 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue was poured as well as various sidewalk locations.
- Washington from 19<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue has been closed. 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue is still open to north-south traffic. 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue to 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue is still closed as well.
- Lindahl will complete grading and paving of first layer of binder course from 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue.
- Lindahl will continue with concrete removals and excavations from 19<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Avenues.
- Humir will complete the inserta valve and watermain disconnect at 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

#### 1-290 Corridor Storm Sewer Separation Improvements

- Storm sewer installation was completed at Congress and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Congress and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Various manhole reconstructs were completed on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Storm sewer installation was continued on 8th Avenue from Harrison to Van Buren.
- Watermain installation was continued on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Congress to Van Buren.
- Concrete restorations occurred on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Harrison to Van Buren and on Van Buren from 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenues.
- $\bullet$  Concrete restorations continued on  $2^{nd}$  Avenue and Van Buren and Congress from  $2^{nd}$  to  $3^{rd}$  Avenue .
- Concrete removals and excavation continued in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue areas.
- Acqua out backfilling concrete, completing concrete prep work/ removals and clean up.
- Jetting trenches occurred on Saturday.
- Concrete restoration on will continue on 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue with curb and gutter and sidewalk restorations. Also Van Buren and Congress will have sidewalks and driveways restored with concrete as well.
- Excavation and removals will continue on 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue areas from Harrison to Van Buren during the week.
- Watermain services will begin on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Congress to Van Buren.
- Storm sewer installation will continue on Van Buren from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Congress from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Various storm sewer catch basins, manhole reconstructs to be completed as well.

# Des Plaines River Trail Talks along with Sewer & Storm Water Separation Community Meetings

Over the last year, the <u>Active Transportation Alliance</u>, <u>Civiltech Engineering</u>, <u>Inc.</u> and <u>Cook County</u> have been exploring how the Des Plaines River Trail can be extended from the CTA Forest Park Blue Line Station and Illinois Prairie Path in the Village of Maywood to the Salt Creek Trail near 26th Street in North Riverside. Thank you for a successful meeting with leaders in Franklin Park and a successful public listening session at <u>Proviso East High School</u> where we learned about findings, viewed potential trail alignments, and provided feedback to make it easier and safer to bike and walk through <u>Village of Maywood</u>, Broadview, Forest Park, and North Riverside.

The Village is receiving \$4,000,000 in funding from the <u>Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago</u> Storm Water Partnership Program for Phase I construction, as well as \$3,564,000 in funding from the <u>Cook County Government</u> Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program. The <u>Illinois Department of Transportation</u> is also partnering with the Village and supporting future stages of the project. "Our sewer system for this area as a major project has gone neglected for decades."

## Village of Maywood Joins City Inclusive Entrepreneurship Program with National League of Cities

Commits to Venture Capital for Black-Owned Firms and Mapping Entrepreneurial Resources to give underrepresented entrepreneurs more opportunities for economic advancement

**Maywood, IL** – The Village of Maywood announces it has joined the City Inclusive Entrepreneurial program. This commitment was made at the National League of Cities (NLC) City Summit as part of the City Inclusive Entrepreneurship (CIE) program, which will provide Maywood with resources and support to help entrepreneurs of color and from other under-represented backgrounds achieve greater economic mobility, reduce the racial wealth gap, and improve access, opportunity, knowledge, and funding for historically under-represented groups.

"Maywood is a historic culturally rich community. By the 1960's, our Village of Eternal Light had a Black Business District of 65 Black-Owned Businesses," said **Nathaniel George Booker, Village President of Maywood,** . "Today, none of those businesses are open and the district is now residential with nothing to show it ever existed. As we focus on Elements of a Healthy Maywood and continue in Moving Maywood Forward Together, I am excited about this partnership. The CIE will be a part of Elements of a Healthy Maywood; Social & Cultural Cohesion and Economic Opportunities focus areas."

The CIE program, an initiative of the <u>National League of Cities</u>, helps cities adopt policies, programs and practices to give underrepresented entrepreneurs more opportunities for economic advancement. Participants select an area of focus for their programs to support economic growth in their communities, including working with startups, creating microlending platforms and improving access to procurement opportunities for MWBEs. Now in its fourth year, this network has grown to include more than 200 cities, 250 local partners, and \$100 million in committed resources.

"Leaders of America's cities, towns and villages recognize that racial and gender equity are key ingredients to economic growth in communities," said **Clarence E. Anthony, CEO and Executive Director of NLC.** "We look forward to working with new members of the City Inclusive Entrepreneurship program to bring their commitments to fruition and create economies in which everyone wins."

Maywood joins 55 other cities from across the country that have made a total of 71 commitments. As part of its participation in the CIE program, Maywood will receive direct technical assistance, information sharing with other cities and partner organizations and financial support to help implement its program.
