

RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-51

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD AND
THE COOK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE REGARDING
TASER ELECTRICAL CONDUCTED WEAPON TRAINING**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood (the "Village Board"), operating as a home rule municipality, have all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Sections 6 and 10(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood ("Village") and the Cook County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO") have jointly determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to provide Maywood personnel with TASER Electrical Conducted Weapon Training; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood and the Cook County Sheriff's Office desire to approve and enter into an agreement entitled "TRAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COOK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE MAYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT" (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule powers and contracting authority provided by Article VII, Sections 6 and 10(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, as well as the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220), the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood have the authority to approve and enter into the attached Agreement (Exhibit "1") to arrange for the Maywood Police Department personnel to participate in the TASER Electrical Conducted Weapon Training as provided for under the Agreement, and find that entering into the Agreement is in the best interests of the Village, its residents, business owners and the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1 and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood authorize the approval and execution of an agreement with the Cook County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO") entitled "TRAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COOK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE MAYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT" (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof. The President and Board of Trustees authorize and direct the Village President and the Village Clerk, or their designees, to execute the final version of the Agreement, which may contain non-substantive and non-financial modifications, provided that the modifications are approved by the Village Attorney, and to execute and deliver all other instruments and documents that are necessary to fulfill the Village's obligations under the Agreement.

SECTION 3: The President and Board of Trustees further authorize the appropriation and approve the expenditure of its General Funds, or such other eligible, available Village funds, to pay for

the Maywood Police Department personnel to participate in the TASER Electrical Conducted Weapon Training as provided for under the Agreement.

SECTION 4: The President and Board of Trustees further authorize and direct Village Clerk, or her designee, to transmit executed duplicate originals or certified copies of this Resolution and the Agreement and such other required documents to the CCSO and to all other parties and agencies that are entitled to receive such documents under the Agreement in order to comply with the terms of the Agreement.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval in the manner provided by law.

**TRAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE COOK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND
THE MAYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT**

This Training Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the Cook County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO") and Maywood Police Department ("Maywood") (collectively, the "Parties"), pursuant to authority granted by the Illinois Constitution of 1970, Article VII, Section 10 and Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to memorialize the partnership between the CCSO and Maywood, wherein the CCSO will provide TASER Electrical Conducted Weapon ("ECW") training to Maywood personnel.

II. SERVICES PROVIDED BY CCSO

The CCSO shall provide TASER training to Maywood. CCSO shall assign a TASER Instructor, certified by AXON Enterprises, Inc., to provide live, hands-on instruction to Maywood Police Department sworn personnel. The CCSO shall provide such training in accordance with the following terms:

- A. Scheduling. The CCSO shall provide TASER training on a date mutually agreed upon by both Parties at the Sheriff's Police Academy, Triton College, 2000 North 5th Avenue, Robert Collins Building, River Grove, Illinois 60171. Any modification to this date and location shall be made with reasonable notice to either Party and by mutual agreement. The Parties may, from time to time, schedule additional training by mutual agreement.
- B. Equipment. Maywood shall provide all necessary equipment for TASER ECW training certification.

III. MUTUAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- A. Effective Date. This Agreement will become effective upon the date of written acceptance by all Parties hereto.
- B. Amendment. This Agreement may be amended with the written consent of all Parties hereto. Provisions relating to the following may be re-adjusted from time to time, as conditions require informal agreement between duly authorized agents of the Parties hereto. In no case shall any adjustment exceed thirty (30) days, unless written in the form of a formal amendment hereto.
- C. Severability. Any section of this Agreement found unconstitutional may be severed from it and the remaining provisions of this Agreement will remain in force.
- D. Applicable Law. This Agreement will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of the State of Illinois.

- E. Term of Agreement: Renewal. The term of this Agreement will be for a period of one (1) year and will commence immediately upon the execution of this Agreement. This Agreement shall renew automatically, under the terms and conditions set forth herein, for additional one (1) year terms until terminated by either Party in accordance with Section III.F.
- F. Termination of Agreement. Either Party to this Agreement may terminate this Agreement for any reason whatsoever, by giving the other Party hereto thirty (30) days written notice of said termination.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the Parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed by their authorized representatives.
