REPORTS:

- Assessor no report
- Clerk Clerk Bonin reminded everyone the last day to register for the General Election is tomorrow, October 18, 2022. The General election is November 8, 2022. Polls are open from 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
- Emergency Management (OEM/State Police/Fire) Mayor Heck has meeting with county soon to go over the plan. He commented on last year storms and best practices.
- Finance/Tax Collection no report
- Historic Commission no report
- Recreation Commission Mayor Heck reported that the Recreation Committee is working on a Halloween project, something new.

COUNCIL REPORTS:

- Buildings and Grounds Mayor Heck reported he will be doing tree work around town with a company. He said there is one bad sidewalk he would like to get repaired before end of year.
- Planning Board Councilman Galli reported that Van Cleef has submitted a new development plan that has garages in front, shortening frontage etc. The Planning Board did not accept, it is being reviewed by Planning Board members and they will comment.
- Traffic and Roads Council President Kidd reported that Sealmaster did not receive our c/o for crack sealer and material. He will speak with the CFO. Mayor Heck said the county was doing their sealcoating. The Mayor was on scene to make sure traffic rerouting done right. He also stated that he spoke to county about an extra crosswalk. They will review the curbing in 2024. Council President Kidd asked about adding a traffic light. Mayor Heck stated he spoke to county about traffic study.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Heck reported that he spoke to a county commissioner about traffic and speeding on Main St/Rt 533. They had a discussion of the best practices for speed reduction and even inspected the road. He then



followed up with the county administrator and brought residents with him. Mayor Heck also spoke to the Under sheriff about additional traffic patrols. The County feels the sheriff department could help with increased presence. Would need them in off peak hours, midday and later evening.

The Mayor also spoke to county about the upcoming changes to the tier 1 and tier 2 stormwater management plan which will require expensive upgrades to our stormwater management infrastructure. The Mayor is looking for county and state financial assistance.

Henry Wierzbowski of 1444 Millstone River Road wished to discuss several items. He stated speeding continues during rush hours and Saturdays. He also asked about the bid for solid waste services and stated that Dave's bid came in lower, about a \$40,000 savings over 5 years. Mayor Heck and Attorney Offen explained that NJ purchasing laws require that we take the 'lowest responsible bidders'. More than just cost must be considered. The purchasing agent is preparing a report on the matter and a bid will be awarded in November.

Mr. Weirzbowski asked about the time frame for the installation of traffic calming devices. Mayor Heck stated he has no notification from the county. He will reach out to them for a timeline.


