ORDINANCE 98-180C AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STOPPING AND STANDING OF VEHICLES ON PARTS OF NORTH RIVER STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLSTONE, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. <u>Definition.</u> For purposes of this ordinance, the following definition shall apply:
 - a. Stopping and Standing shall be defined as set forth in N. J. S. A. 39:1-1.
 - b. Vehicle shall be defined as set forth in N.J.S.A. 39:1-1.
- 2. Prohibited action. No person, firm, partnership or corporation shall cause or allow a vehicle to be stopped or to stand on the westerly side of North River Street for its entire length. On the easterly side of North River Street, the no parking area will commence a distance of 400 feet, as measured along the curb line of North River Street from its intersection with the north side line of Amwell Road (County Route 514) and shall continue along North River Street to a point distant 625 feet, as measured from the same north side line of Amwell Road. The prohibition defined herein shall be adhered to except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or traffic control signal or sign. However, prohibition contained hereunder shall not apply to the stopping or standing of a vehicle in any drive, driveway, cutout, or parking area which is off the main travel portion of North River Street.
- 3. <u>Signs</u>: Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the regulations provided in this ordinance.
- 4. <u>Penalty</u>: Any person, firm, partnership or corporation convicted of a violation of this ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$50.00 or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 15 days or both.
- 5. Approval: This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as is required by law.
