PUBLIC NOTICE
ORDINANCE NO. C-86
AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF BOROUGH MARSHAL IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLSTONE, COUNTY OF SOMERSET AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section One— There is hereby created the office of Borough Marshal for the Borough of Millstone. Said office is created pursuant to the powers contained in N.J.S.A. 40:27-15.

Section Two— The duties of the Borough Marshal shall be as follows:

- a. Enforce traffic regulations, ordinances and statutes;
- b. Aid in traffic control and direction within the Borough;
- c. Investigate traffic accidents;
- d. Make arrests for and assist in the prosecution of persons charged with traffic violations;
- e. Co-operate with other Borough officials in the administration of traffic ordinances;
- f. Co-operate with other Borough officials in the development of ways and means to improve traffic conditions within the Borough; and
- g. Perform such other law enforcement or traffic duties as may be designated by the Borough Council.

Section Three— The Borough Marshal be and is hereby authorized to issue Summonses on behalf of the Borough of Millstone to individuals whom he believes have violated traffic regulations, ordinances or statutes. Said Summonses shall be issued upon a standard form Summonses which shall be supplied to the Borough Marshal by the Borough.

Section Four— The Borough Marshal shall be provided with a symbol of his position, by the Borough of Millstone. Said symbol shall be displayed conspicuously by the Borough Marshal when on duty.

Section Five— The Borough Marshal is not authorized to carry firearms by virtue of his position as Borough Marshal.

Section Six— The Borough Marshal shall keep records with respect to any traffic Summonses issued by him or with respect to any traffic accidents investigated by him. In addition to any other pertinent traffic data or information, the said record shall contain the following information:

- a. The name, address and driver's license number of the individual or individuals involved in the accident or alleged traffic violation;
- b. The nature of the alleged traffic violation;
- c. The names and addresses of any witnesses;
- d. The nature of any statements taken in connection with the accident or alleged violation;
- e. The location within the Borough of the alleged violation or accident.

Section Seven The residency and term requirements contained in N.J.S.A. 40:27-15 or as it may be amended, shall apply to the Borough Marshal.

Section Eight The hours of work and the compensation for the Borough Marshal shall be determined by the Borough Council with a view to the best interests of the general public and the Borough of Millstone.

Section Nine This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in the manner provided by law.

The ordinance published herewith was passed upon second reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone in the County of Somerset, New Jersey held on January 9, 1979. It will be further considered for final passage after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the said Borough Council, to be held in the Borough Hall in said Borough on February 7, 1979 at 8:30 P.M. local time, at which time and place or any time and place to which the meeting shall be adjourned all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard considering such ordinance.
