ORDINANCE 2018-02

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 21.06.B.1 OF THE MONTROSE CITY CODE
CALLING FOR ROLL CALL VOTES FOR ANY QUESTION PENDING BEFORE THE
COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted an ordinance, codified as § 21.06.B.1 of the Montrose City Code, which calls for “the votes of members on any question pending before the Council will be by roll call vote”; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance regulation has been violated on any number of occasions since its adoption; and

WHEREAS, it is not necessary to conduct roll call votes on routine Council business; and

WHEREAS, a roll call vote is not necessary to ascertain the Members who are not on the prevailing side of a vote; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to eliminate this subsection of Chapter 21.06.


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTROSE:

- A. That the first sentence of Section 21.06.B.1 – “The votes of members on any question pending before the Council will be by roll call vote.” - is hereby repealed.
- B. After adoption of this Ordinance, Section 21.06.B.1 of the City Code shall be as follows:
“If the vote is not unanimous the names of those voting against the questions and those abstaining shall be recorded in the minutes.”
