DEPARTMENT REPORTS

- A. Parks – Director Bundy reported on the following:
 - Completed pavement markings on Island Park trail addition as well as signage and plantings. Ready to submit completed project to MDNRTF for grant reimbursement.
 - Staff working on fall projects including leaf mulching, prepping flowerbeds and sports fields for winter, cleaning up various graffiti areas.
 - Winterization of irrigation, including Island Park Ball Fields. The first year winterization of this project was included in the bid price.
 - Master Plan Public Hearing set for Nov. 9 City Commission meeting. Parks Commissioners who wish to attend can do so via Zoom or view on YouTube.
- B. Recreation – Director Longoria reported on the following
 - PEAK afterschool programming continues. Staff working with Human Resources regarding exposures and quarantine management.
 - Youth soccer and flag programs wrapped up last weekend. Staff working with schools to keep informed when classrooms move to virtual learning because of an exposure.
 - Currently taking registrations for youth basketball and volleyball, held at Morey Courts.
 - Staff met with Downtown Coordinator planning for safe events to keep the community engaged during pandemic. Christmas celebration, Man vs. Mountain and Daddy Daughter Date Night may look different from years' past; however, staff would like to continue its presence in the community.

- Last week for the 2020 Farmer's Market is Thursday 10/29. Very high compliments given to Carol Moody for the planning and implementation of the market during the pandemic.
- Chippewa River Master Plan – Site evaluation done by Consultants, waiting on results. Core committee to meet the week of November 2nd.
