I. Trust

- Refrain from using position, either regular or volunteer, to secure special privilege, gain, or benefit for ourselves.
- Be committed to the appropriate use of the City's assets and resources.

II. Honesty

- Be truthful in all endeavors, honest, and sincere with each other and those we serve.

III. Service and Contribution

- Ensure all actions taken and decisions made are in the best interest of those we serve.

IV. Responsibility

- Take responsibility for actions and hold each other accountable.
- Make sound decisions based on facts that preserve the best interest of the community.

V. Respect

- Treat all people with dignity and respect.
- Engage in teamwork, be open to listening, feedback, and differing perceptions.
- Understand how our behaviors and actions affect everyone with whom we interact.
