She would like to know what the City can do or if Council has recommendations for her to proceed. She asked if Council as a body could possibly write a letter to the Rodeo regarding the Rabbit Scramble and the issues that residents have.

#### CITY ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

City Administrator Lonnie Rainville shared that the City has launched a Facebook page, City of Myrtle Creek Government. We will be using this to push information out to the public. The City Administrator has started meeting with the City Administrators from Riddle, Canyonville, and Glendale. They will start meeting every other month to discuss local issues specific to south Douglas County. The City Administrator also shared the new insurance rates for the 2023/2024. The City has an open position for a Parks/Public Works employee. Interviews are being conducted on Friday, June 23, 2023 and we hope to have the new employee on staff in July. The Brewfest and the City Wide Yard Sale are both going on this weekend.

Honorable Mayor and City Council,

The Government Accounting Standard Board (GASB) has issued a new standard for accounting practices for entities that use an accrual-based accounting system. The new standard will require all subscription-based IT products to be compiled and their value measured for the subscription term. Amortization of the subscription's liability would then have to be reported during each fiscal year. The City of Myrtle Creek currently uses an accrual-based accounting system.

We have met with our auditing team at Umpqua Valley Financial to review what this process will look like for the City of Myrtle Creek and for their recommendations for moving forward. The recommendation from Umpqua Valley Financial is for the City to move to a modified cash-based accounting system to avoid the new requirements.

Before we make a decision on switching our accounting practices, the auditor suggested that we reach out to a company called Debtbook that compiles the information required by GASB 96 and review with them what the new requirements for accrual-based accounting would be for the City if we were to remain with our current accounting system. During our meeting with Debtbook we were informed that the cost of their services would run a minimum of \$10,000. Our audit team would also require more time to compile and review the information provided to them by Debtbook, which would increase our audit costs.

We did speak with Umpqua Valley Financial about what it would look like for the City if we switched to a modified cash-based accounting system. They informed us that they do work with other cities who use this accounting system and there have not been any issues. We also reached out to Business Oregon to verify that the City's ability to receive a loan, if needed, would not be affected negatively if we were to switch to a modified cash-based accounting system. Business Oregon could not see any reason that future loans would be affected by switching the accounting system used.

The options presented include staying with the accrual-based accounting system that the City currently uses and either contracting with Debtbook to compile the data needed or uses staff resources to compile the information in house, or to switch the City accounting to a modified cash-based accounting system. If the City were to stay with the accrual-based accounting system, there would additional costs to the City both from Debtbook and from the auditing process.

From the information gathered and the time spent speaking with the auditor I feel confident in following Umpqua Valley Financials' recommendation to move the City to a modified cash-based accounting system. This option will save a substantial amount of money and staff time. I believe that with working with the auditor and staff we can make this a seamless change.

# Placement of Donated Items/Memorials on City Property Policy

#### **Summary:**

This policy shall outline the procedure for donated items and memorial to be placed on City owned property. The policy shall also outline the responsibilities, obligations and responsibilities the City will have regarding donated property and memorials.

#### **City Consideration or request:**

The city will consider on a case-by-case basis requests from a person or group to place a donated item on city property. Donated property will only be considered if the approved procedure is followed, and the donated property meets the standards for construction or species in the case of tree or shrub.

Benches shall be made of wood and shall be contoured or flat style pedestal outdoor bench. Alternative bench material may be approved on a case-by-case basis by the city parks commission.

Trees or shrubs to be planted in City facilities must be approved by the Parks and Building Coordinator as well as the Parks Commission. Trees or shrubs must fit in with the existing landscape scheme of facilities.

Other decorative art features or equipment may also be considered on a case-by-case basis and must be approved by the Parks Commission.

Plaques may be placed with the donated items and not as a free stand-alone feature. Plaques set in a feature may be no larger than 8 % x 11 inches. Plaques affixed to benches may not exceed 2 % x 6 inches. Plaque design must be approved by the Parks commission.

#### No Guarantee of Approval:

Consideration of an application by the City does not guarantee approval. The City reserves the right to approve or deny any application for placement of donated items.

#### **Additional Agency Approval:**

The Parks Commission and City Administrator will determine any additional agencies, if any must review an application grant approval for placement of items.

#### **Disposition of Donated Items:**

The Parks Commission shall determine the useful life of a donated item and shall determine the disposition of the items if the item is damaged or reaches its end of life span.

#### No Guarantee or Obligation:

The City cannot guarantee the security of items donated and placed on public property. Placement on public property does not obligate the City to repair or replace items.

#### Removal of Items:

The Parks Commission or City Council has the authority to approve the permanent removal of donated items. The City Administration has the authority to temporarily remove donated items.

#### **Donor repair or Replacement of Items:**

If the City elects to not repair or replace damaged items, the City may attempt to contact the original donor to be given the opportunity to repair or remove the item. Repair or replacement of an items does not obligate the city to placement of an item.

#### Damaged items:

Damaged items which are not repaired, replaced or recovered by donors within the determined time period given by the City Administrator may be discarded at the discretion of the Parks Commission.

#### **Procedures:**

- Application for Placement of Donate Item on Public Property is completed and submitted to the City Administrator.
- City Administrator reviews for completeness
- City Administrator discusses application with Parks and Buildings Coordinator to get sign off on donated item and location of placement.
- Application is presented to the Parks Commission at the next regularly scheduled Parks Commission meeting.
- If the Parks Commission approves any other agencies identified as needing to give approval will be sent application materials with request for approval.
- If all outside agencies, if any, approve the application the Parks and Buildings Coordinator will be notified to work with the donor on obtaining the donating item and placing it in the approved location.
- All information pertaining to the donated item will be retained by the Parks and Building Coordinator with copies given to the City Recorder.

#### **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the approval of the concept to expand the Millsite Park walking paths and allow staff to begin design work and develop project cost and identify potential funding which would include City funds as well as potential grants.

#### **Background:**

There is currently a .7 mile trail that runs along the perimeter of Millsite field. City Parks staff have been removing blackberries along the bank west of the RV Park and have opened up areas that would allow for the expansion of pedestrian trails along Myrtle Creek. The trail would cross under the railroad tracks at the south end of the disc golf course and parallel the South Umpqua River to the bridge entering town. It would then circle back, cross back under the railroad tracks on the north end of the disc golf course, and then connect back into the existing trail. This would add approximately half a mile of new trail. Attachment A is an aerial map depicting the existing trail and the potential new trail.

The proposal was presented to the Parks Commission on June 13, 2023. The Commission voted to move the issue to City Council with the recommendation for Council to approve moving the project forward.

Engineering costs estimated at no more than \$5,000.
