Payment Options Frequently Asked Questions

How will I know the amount of any fine and surcharge?

Once the Court has accepted a guilty plea the presiding judge will set the fine and the Court Clerk will mail you an invoice. The invoice will list the charges, the date payment is due, and the amount of any fines and / or mandatory surcharges you must pay.

How can I make payments?

All payments must be for the exact amount shown on the invoice.

If you pay a fine by mail it must be for the exact amount and be in the form of a certified check or money order payable to the Town of North Elba Court. Personal checks are accepted if they are paid in person.

If you wish to pay by credit card fill out the form at the bottom of the invoice and return it to the Court. A 2.99% service fee will automatically be assessed on all credit card payments. The Court does not receive any portion of the service fee. Two receipts for payment will be generated and sent to you. One receipt will be for the fines and/or surcharges imposed by the Court and one receipt will be for the service charge.
