Rural Housing Assessment Grant	\$10,000 (fixed amount)	\$5,000	Grows local housing capacity through consultation	Provides funding for housing assessment data collection and the Iowa State University Extension & Outreach Rural Housing Assessment Readiness Workshop. Funds may be used to fulfill that process at the discretion of the grant recipient but must contribute to the completion of the housing assessment report, workshop, or implementation of the workshop outcomes within the contract period. Rural Child Care Planning Grant	\$10,000	½ of grant amount	Consult with childcare professionals to plan for childcare needs, facilities, and programs	Through greater understanding of their geographic market, demographics, competition, financials, and other factors, communities can be armed with the information needed to take proactive steps towards addressing childcare challenges. Funding from the programs will empower communities to assess their current childcare environment and develop strategies.	July 17, 2 PM
Rural Enrichment Grant	\$20,000	½ of grant amount but at least \$5,000	Implement projects to advance the community along in its revitalization	Supports small quality of life projects that will create meaningful results in rural communities. Developing quality spaces for people to want to live, work, play, and engage will support the vibrancy of Iowa's rural places. Eligible projects must be open to the public and contribute to the vitality and engagement of the community.	July 13, 9AM

Rural Scale Up Grant	\$20,000	½ of grant amount but at least \$5,000	Implement projects to advance the community along in its revitalization	<p>In 2020, the Center for Rural Revitalization, a division of the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA), launched the Rural Innovation Grant program, supporting creative and unique solutions to rural challenges. Over the past three funding cycles, grant recipients have illustrated best practices that are now primed for sharing across the state. Funding from the Scale-Up Grant program will assist other communities with the opportunity to implement these solutions. Extra consideration is provided to projects that have been endorsed by the Iowa Great Places Citizen’s Advisory Board, those located in a community of 5,000 or fewer, and those that scale-up a former Rural Innovation grantee project.</p>	July 19, 9 AM
